Affordable housing properties at a glance

The Santa Fe Civic Housing Authority, which broke off from city government in 1989 and established itself as a nonprofit housing authority, plays a massive role in local affordable and public housing. It has an ownership stake in about 1,400 affordable housing units, almost all in Santa Fe, and administers about 1,000 federal housing vouchers for low-income tenants in the city.
