

My son was a member of the
200th ~~AA~~ Coast Artillery (AA). He
left for the Philippines on August 20,
1941, and was stationed at Fort Stotsenburg,
Campanga, Philippine Islands when
the war started. He was reported Prisoner
of war on January 31, 1943. He was interned
in the Philippine Military Prison Camp
No. I, up until November 26, when we
got a notice from the War Department
that he had been transferred to Tokyo
Camp, Tokyo Japan.

We have received six post cards
from him, all of them stating that
his health is good, he is uninjured and
not under any treatment.
