Comes now David Waymire, Deputy District Attorney, and enters a *Nolle Prosequi* dismissing the above captioned case without prejudice. Defendant has been sentenced to an incarceration term of 30 years in federal court which was to be concurrent with this state case. The federal sentence was then run consecutively instead of concurrently, which resulted in a habeas issue and Defendant was allowed to withdraw his prior plea on this state case. The underlying date of incident of this case is from 2007. There is not sufficient evidence to prove this case beyond a reasonable doubt at this point in time. Therefore, this case is dismissed without prejudice. If additional evidence comes to light, the State may re-file this case. Defendant remains incarcerated at the U.S. Bureau of Prisons on his 30 year federal sentence.
