

<b>ORDINANCE NO. 2025-22</b> <b>AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2024- 27</b> <b>A FEE SCHEDULE FOR ALL DEPARTMENTS</b> <b>OF THE TOWN OF EDINBURGH</b>	
Be it enacted and ordained by the Edinburgh Town Council that:

<b>XI. SECTION 11. REPEALER</b>	
a. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.	
<b>XII. SECTION 12. SEVERABILITY</b>	
a. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by the Courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.	
<b>XIII. SECTION 13. EFFECTIVE DATE</b>	
a. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after the date of the publication described in Section 10.
