- How you can protect your children's inheritance from creditors, non-family members, and divorce.

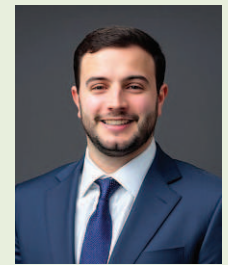
