Registering to Vote in La Salle County

WHAT ARE THE VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS?

A United States citizen is eligible to register to vote if: the citizen is at least 18 years old or will become 18 years old on or before the date of the next election, and if the citizen has been a resident or will have been a resident of his or her precinct for 30 days before the date of the next election the citizen must provide two forms of identification.

1. Verification of name

(physical copies required)

2. Verification of address

GRACE PERIOD REGISTRATION is an extension of regular registration in which a person may register to vote or transfer their registration due to a name or address change. This method of registration is only available in the County Clerk's office and requires the individual to vote at the same time. Dates for **GRACE PERIOD REGISTRATION/VOTING** are **MARCH 5, 2025** through **APRIL 1, 2025**.

SAME DAY REGISTRATION is available at each individual polling place or at the County Clerks Office, but **ONLY on election day**.

WHAT FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION MAY BE NEEDED WHEN REGISTERING TO VOTE?

Two forms of identification with at least one showing your current residence address are needed when you register in-person. If you register by mail, sufficient proof of identity is required by submission of your driver's license number or State identification card number. If you do not have either of those, verification by the last 4 digits of your social security number, a copy of a current and valid photo identification, or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, or other government document that shows your name and address will be required. A person may also demonstrate sufficient proof of identity by submission of an identification card issued by a college or university accompanied by either a copy of the applicant's contract or lease for a residence or any postmarked mail (*postmarked within 30 days*) delivered to the applicant at their current residence address.

WRITE-IN VOTES

On the Optical Scan Voting System a line is provided for casting a write-in vote following the name(s) of the candidate(s) or the designation "No Candidate Filed" for each office where a declaration of intent to be a write-in has been filed.

To accomplish your write-in vote, you must print the name of the write-in candidate on the line and darken the oval to the left of the name you write-in. (See illustration below)

State law requires that Judges of Election do not count any write-in votes for anyone, unless the Judges have been notified by the County Clerk that the "Declaration of Intent to be a Write-in Candidate" has been filed with the County Clerk's office.

This law requires that anyone running as a write-in candidate must file the "Declaration of Intent to be a Write-in Candidate" with the County Clerk's office by the 61st day prior to the election.

Anyone wishing to run as a write-in candidate must file the form; this holds true in all cases, both where the designation "No Candidate" appears on the Ballot, and where the full number of candidates to be elected appear on the ballot.

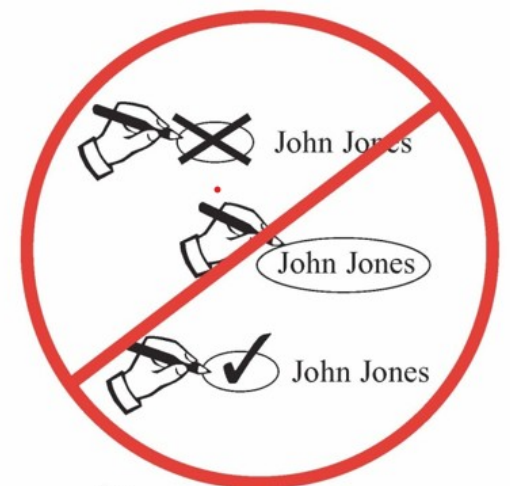

Vote By Mail Frequently Asked Questions

If you submitted a Permanent Vote by Mail Application and opted in to receive your Ballot by Mail, the La Salle County Clerks office will begin mailing ballots on February 20, 2025. Please call the County Clerks Office to verify if your ballot has been mailed 815-484-8202.

How do I return my ballot after I get it?

You can mail it, deliver it in person to the La Salle County Clerks office, or drop it in the secure ballot drop box located in the (East Parking Lot) of 707 E. Etna Rd, Ottawa, IL 61350.

If you no longer wish to Vote By Mail Permanently, please fill out a new Permanent Vote by Mail Application and indicate that you wish NOT to enroll in the Permanent Vote By Mail Enrollment Application list.

Please visit our website <https://lasallecountyil.gov/288/Vote-by-Mail> to print a new Permanent Vote by Mail Application, see Page 30 of the Specimen Ballot or stop by the La Salle County Clerks office to pick up a new application.

What if I request a mail ballot but decide I'd rather vote in person?

- If you have already received your mailed ballot (do not shred or throw away), **take it with you to your early voting site or polling place on Election Day and surrender it to an election judge.** Your mailed ballot will be *spoiled*, and you will receive a new ballot.
- If you have not yet received your mailed ballot, you will be asked to sign an affidavit certifying you have not received your mailed ballot. You will then be issued a new ballot.
- If you received your mailed ballot but lost it or discarded it, you may sign an affidavit certifying you have not yet voted in this election. You will then be issued a new ballot and asked to sign a provisional affidavit. See page 32 for more information on Provisional voting.

If you receive your vote by mail ballot after you have voted, you must return it marked spoiled to the County Clerk's office. Do not attempt to vote your mail ballot after you have voted in person.

Doing so is a Class 3 felony. (And because voting systems will not allow more than one vote per voter, your mail ballot will be rejected.)

My ballot is damaged and I can't mark it, what should I do?

Contact your local election authority immediately. If time permits, you may receive a replacement ballot. If there is not sufficient time to deliver a new ballot, you can surrender the damaged ballot at an early voting location or your precinct polling place on Election Day and vote in person. Emergencies like these are why the Board of Elections recommends applying early for a mail ballot and returning it as soon as possible.

What is the deadline for returning a mail ballot?

Ballots sent through the U.S. Postal Service must be postmarked on or before April 1 for the Consolidated Election. They must arrive at the office of the local election authority by April 15 for the Consolidated Election, to be counted. Voters can deposit ballots into the secure ballot drop box located in the (East Parking Lot) of 707 E. Etna Rd, Ottawa, IL 61350, until the close of polls at 7 p.m. on Election Day.

Can someone else deliver my mail ballot in person to my local election authority office?

Yes, but the voter and the person delivering the ballot must fill out the affidavit on the return envelope acknowledging third-party delivery.

How will I know if my ballot has been received and counted?

Contact your local election authority to verify that your ballot was received.



What is provisional voting?

Provisional voting is available if there is a question regarding someone's registration status or eligibility to vote in an election.

A provisional voter uses a regular ballot, but will only be counted if the Election Authority's office can verify after Election Day that you are registered and qualified to vote in the election and have not already voted.

***If you are voting provisionally you must provide a photo copy of your ID along with the provisional envelope or within 7 days of the election by fax/email/mail or in person at the County Clerks office.**

Why Your Ballot is Provisional

- Your name does not appear on the official list of eligible voters for this precinct.
- Your voting status has been challenged and a majority of the judges agree. (A challenge may be made by an election judge, poll watcher, or another registered voter.)
- You registered to vote by mail and were required to show identification when voting in person and you did not provide such ID.
- Your name appears on the list of early voters, but you claim not to have voted.
- You received a Vote By Mail Ballot, but did not return it to the election authority.

After The Polls Close

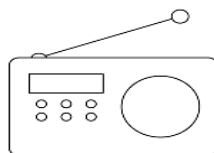
- The Election Authority's office receives all provisional ballots and verifies the registration information for each provisional voter within two weeks after the election, with the last day being the 14th day following Election Day.
- If the Election Authority's office determines that you are registered and eligible to vote, the envelope is opened and your ballot is counted.
- If you are not registered, the envelope will not be opened and the votes you cast will not count. However, the information you supplied on the envelope will serve as a registration application.
- If you registered by mail and were required to submit ID, but failed to do so, your voter registration remains incomplete; therefore, the ballot will not be counted.
