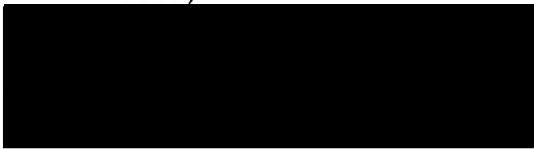

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2019, in Franklin County, Kentucky, the above named defendant: Mark Kopp committed the offense of Criminal Attempt at Bribery of a Public Servant when he, acting with the kind of culpability otherwise required for the commission of the crime, he intentionally engaged in conduct which would constitute the crime of Bribery of a Public Servant if the attendant circumstances were as he believed them to be, or, intentionally did or omitted to do anything which, under the circumstances as he believed them to be, is a substantial step in a course of conduct planned to culminate in his commission of the crime.
