

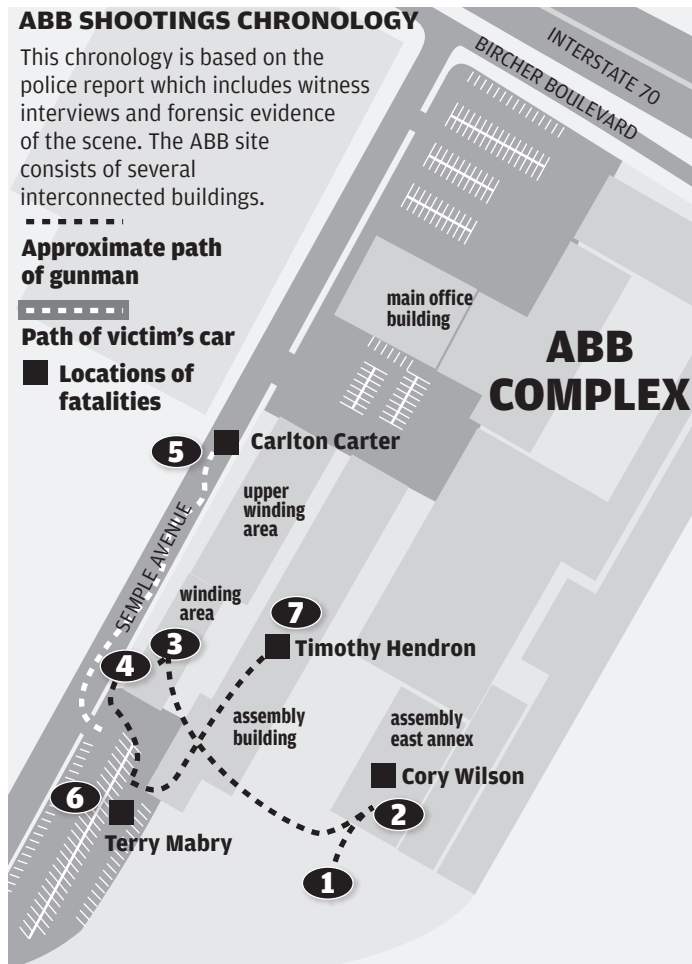
## ABB SHOOTINGS CHRONOLOGY

This chronology is based on the police report which includes witness interviews and forensic evidence of the scene. The ABB site consists of several interconnected buildings.

**1** Timothy Hendron parks near the loading dock and enters the assembly east annex building where a group of employees are gathered for their morning meeting.

**2** Hendron opens fire on the group, which includes Jerry Brown, Rick Lawrence, Derrick Harris, Vickie Wilson, Tony Edwards and Darrell Buckley. Brown sustains a gunshot wound to his leg, but continues running, eventually making his way to the roof of the building. Buckley is shot once in the leg as he runs toward the office of Cory Wilson. Both take cover inside a storage closet in Wilson's office. Hendron fires about 30 rounds through the wall of the closet, striking Wilson fatally and hitting Buckley in the abdomen and chest.

**3** Hendron then leaves the east annex building and into the winding area, where he shoots Keith Garner and Terry Mabry in the leg.

**4** Hendron then walks outside the winding area onto the paved walk adjacent to the building and sees cars trying to drive away on Semple Avenue. He opens fire on them. One of the drivers, John Green, is shot in the wrist.

**5** Carlton Carter is fatally shot in his car, which continues to roll before coming to rest on the north side of the upper winding area. Officers responding to the scene observe Green's and Carter's cars under fire and are unsure whether they are involved in a gunfight together or whether they are victims.

**7** Hendron then goes back into the assembly building and kills himself inside an office there.

**6** Hendron then sees employees, including Stephen Sharp II, helping the wounded Mabry to safety on a parking lot. Sharp gets his gun from his car and fires six rounds at Hendron, missing him. Hendron then walks over to Mabry, who was on the ground, and fires multiple shots at him, killing him. He then opens fire on the security booth on that parking lot before opening fire on Sharp, who was trying to run away. Nobody is injured in the security booth, but Sharp is shot in the abdomen.
