**PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT**

I, A.Morris DSN 185, an officer with the Troy Missouri Police Department, knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herein are true to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief.

1. I have probable cause to believe on 3/20/23 at unknown hours, the aforementioned defendant did: knowingly cause the death of two individuals after deliberation upon the matter.

On 3/21/2023, family members of the victims, D [REDACTED] and K [REDACTED] M [REDACTED], requested a check on the M [REDACTED]' well-being. Upon Officers arrival, no contact was made. Officers could hear the ringing of telephones, but no movement in the residence. When Officers checked to see if the front door was unlocked, they discovered the residence was unsecure. Due to the nature of the call, the level of concern from family members, hearing no motion within the residence and yet hearing telephone devices, Officers entered the front door. Upon immedite entry, Officers could see an individual (D [REDACTED]) on the ground between the living room and the kitchen. As Officers approached the individual to check the status, a second person (K [REDACTED]) was on the ground in the hallway between the kitchen and master bedroom. The Officers were able to observe spent firearm casings as well as a discharged round. Based off of multiple indicators (wounds, rigor, coloration, blood) Officers knew the individuals were deceased, and conducted a sweep of the residence, making sure no additional victims or suspects were inside the residence. After completing an initial sweep, Officers conducted a second search due to rooms within the residence being filled with a multitude of miscelaneouos items, making it hard to complete an efficient sweep. Officers exited the residence and set up a perimeter; awaiting for the securing of a search warrant to search the residence and process the evidence.

Once the search warrant was obtained, a thorough search of the residence was conducted, along with the processing of the evidence. The Lincoln County Coroner assisted with the death investigation. During said portion of the investigation, multile wounds were located on D.M [REDACTED], consistent with bullet penetration. Wounds were observed in the center of the chest, upper forehead, and finger. Multiple wounds were located on K.M [REDACTED] consistent with bullet penetration. Wounds were observed in the shoulder and hip.

Spent firearm casings were located in the vicinity of the deceased, with one spent round specifically located near D.M [REDACTED] hip. The spent round had purported hair, flesh, and blood

on it. Blood was observed near both individuals on the floor, on the kitchen floor, on the kitchen table, on the kitchen/living room wall, and living room carpet. While conducting the search of the residence, I observed a piece of mail addressed to one Davionne McRoberts (██████████).

Prior to the issuance of the search warrant, I spoke with multiple family members of the deceased. Family members indicated Davionne McRoberts was the grandson of D.M.██████████, step-grandson of K.M.██████████, and had previously stayed at ██████████ off and on. A cousin of Davionne McRoberts, O. Ross, stated Davionne was currently residing with her at ██████████ ██████████. O. Ross stated she lent Davionne McRoberts her vehicle on 3/20/2023 and had not seen or spoken to him since. O. Ross stated the vehicle was a White in Color Dodge Grand Caravan. When Officers arrived on scene for the check of the well being of the victims, the Dodge Caravan which bore MO REGISTRATION: ██████████ was parked in the driveway of ██████████.

Family members detailed alarming Facebook and Instagram messages Davionne McRoberts had posted for a few weeks prior to the locating of the deceased individuals. Family members provided the following information for Davionne McRoberts social media Platforms: FACEBOOK ██████████ SNAPCHAT ██████████. Observing the Facebook platform, I observed multiple posts for the previous two weeks in which Davionne McRoberts identified himself as GOD. Two such posts, both from Saturday March 18<sup>th</sup>, state " I KNOW I KNOW MY EARS ARE RINGING ITS ALMOST TIME BUT NOT YET" and "WHO WANNA DIE TODAY? Y'all don't believe? Come show me I'm not god."

Terrell Chatman, son of K.M.██████████ (Chatman) advised Law Enforcement of a conversation he had with his mother on 3/20/2023, the day she and D.M.██████████ were murdered. Chatman stated it was his birthday. Chatman recalled K.M.██████████ describing an argument between D.M.██████████ and Davionne McRoberts in which Davionne McRoberts threatened to kill his grandfather. Chatman asked if the threat was serious, and advised his mother did not seem concerned about the comments.

On 3/20/2023, employees of SSM Health, 148 Professional Pkwy, observed Davionne McRoberts exit a woodline, wearing only black boxers with green stitching. The witnesses advised Davionne McRoberts asked for a ride, and brought up in conversation Zodiac Signs. The employees last saw Davionne McRoberts heading South toward Jim Trenary Chevrolet of Troy, 200 Professional Pkwy.

On 3/22/2023 at approximately 0800 hours, Law Enforcement for the Barnes Jewish Campus, located at 400 S. Kingshighway, advised Davionne McRoberts had been checked into their facility for approximately since (insert time). Limited information was provided, but what was relayed was Davionne McRoberts arrived via EMS, and was transported to the psychiatric ward for treatment.

On 3/22/2023 at 1240 hours, Davionne McRoberts was cleared from the psychiatric ward and released to the medical side for treatment. It was at that point contact was made with Davionne McRoberts. Davionne McRoberts was advised of his Constitutional Rights per the Miranda Warning. Before completing the rights, Davionne McRoberts took over the reciting of his rights, and stated he understood them. Before any questions were asked, Davionne McRoberts stated he told medical staff his statement, and wished not to speak without representation.

I observed multiple scratches on the arms of Davionne McRoberts. Some scratches were long and straight. Many on the forearms were small and curved, consistent with the width and depth of defensive wounds obtained during a struggle. Davionne McRoberts' feet were covered in scratches and cuts, which Davionne advised (to medical staff) he obtained while running outside

barefoot. Davionne McRoberts had a large laceration in the browline over his left eye, which had been glued by medical staff.

While awaiting Davionne McRoberts' medical clearance from the hospital, to include a fit for confinement, he made multiple statements that he was God or Jesus, and referenced his personal life experiences as how they related to the bible. Davionne McRoberts inquired what my Zodiac sign was, and stated he was a psychic. Davionne McRoberts expressed how he thinks pedofiles steal innocence. Davionne McRoberts informed medical staff he has heard voices since he was a child, being advised by his grandmother he was talking to spirits.

Once cleared by medical personnel, Davionne McRoberts was placed under arrest. Davionne McRoberts requested an interview with this Detective. I obliged, at which time Davionne McRoberts was transported to 800 Cap Au Gris. Upon arrival, Davionne McRoberts was advised his Constitutional Rights per the Miranda Warning were still in effect. Davionne McRoberts stated he wanted to express things which needed to be documented. Davionne McRoberts expressed sexual abuse, physical abuse, and indicated again he was God or Jesus. Davionne McRoberts did not want to express who was responsible for the sexual assault, but clarified he was not gay because a male had sexually assaulted him. Once Davionne McRoberts expressed the things he wished to, I inquired if he was willing to speak about the death of his grandparents, D and K M [REDACTED]. Davionne McRoberts stated he did not wish to speak on the subject.

On 3/24/2023 at approximately 0900 hours, family members of both D.M [REDACTED] and Davionne responded to the Troy Police Department for follow up interviews. Information provided by Davionne's sister and cousin, both of which he resided with, detailed Davionne was wearing a track suit, black in color, addidas with black running shoes. Both the cousin and sister indicated Davionne left the residence on the day of the murders with another roommate, identified as Thomas Caimi. Thomas Caimi also responded for an interivew.

During his interview, Thomas Caimi stated he was with Davionne McRoberts during the day, and that they had got stuck (lack of gas) in Ameristar. Thomas provided a text and time with his girlfiend whom they asked for money from. Thomas stated after getting the gas money, he and Davionne went to Target in the city to pick up a third party, identified only as "Africa". Thomas stated the three of them went to [REDACTED], where he, Africa, and D.M [REDACTED] were sitting on the front porch. Thomas stated Davionne was inside the residence to charge his phone, and indicated K.M [REDACTED] was inside the residene as well. Thomas stated he heard three gun shots at which time D.M [REDACTED] ran insiden the residence. Thomas recalled hearing the name Davionne being yelled by D.M [REDACTED]. Thomas stated he and Africa ran to Casey's convenient store, located at 620 E. Cherry St., Troy MO 63379. Thomas stated he and Africa obtained a ride from the area from a stranger, and had not seen Davionne since the incident. Thomas stated prior to the murders, Davione McRoberts stated it was "Time", when Thomas believed was a reference to becoming famous. Thomas stated Davionne wanted to show him and Africa something and was making references to a sacrifice. Thomas stated he did not know what the statements meant at the time they were made.

While conducting the interviews, I was advised by command staff for Troy PD, articles of clothing matching the description of what Davionne was wearing was located on the suspected path Davionne took from Eames to Professional Pkwy. A bag was located containing multiple identifications for Davionne McRoberts.

In Summation:

-Davionne was the last person seen driving the Dodge Caravan which was left at the scene of the murder

-Davionne referenced killing people on social media, and identified as God

-K.M. [REDACTED] advised her son of an argument between D.M. [REDACTED] and Davionne in which Davionne threatened to kill them (K. and D. M. [REDACTED])

-Davionne was observed in Troy between 1815-1830 hours walking from a woodline wearing only boxers, less than an hour witnesses heard loud reports from the area of the murder location

-Davionne had defensive wounds on his arms, cuts on his feet, a laceration over his eye.

-A witness gave testament to being on the front porch of [REDACTED] at the time the shots were fired, had knowledge Davionne was in possession of a 9 mm pistol, was inside the residence with K.M. [REDACTED], heard D.M. [REDACTED] yell Davionne's name after the first shots and heard additional shots as he (witness) fled.

2. I believe the defendant would not appear in court in response to a criminal summons and/or the defendant poses a danger to the victim, the community, or another person for the following reason(s):

CRIMINAL HISTORY Davionne has no criminal history consistent with this crime.

RESIDENTIAL STATUS Davionne is a resident of [REDACTED], but has bounced from location to location since leaving his wife in Texas.

NATURE OF THE CRIME The crime was unprovoked in nature, and described as a sacrifice to become famous. Davionne fled the murder scene, stripping clothes covered in evidence as he fled. Davionne made no admission, has denied involvement, and has shown no remorse over his actions.

Since this affidavit is submitted only for the purpose of securing an arrest warrant, I have not set forth each and every fact known to me concerning this investigation. I have included what I believe are facts sufficient in establishing probable cause for this arrest warrant.
