Specifically, the bag contained a digital scale, a grinder with residue that lab analysis determined to be heroin, multiple empty capsules, a cutting agent, and a box of plastic sandwich baggies. We also seized over \$10,000 in U.S. currency from the closet in the defendant's bedroom.
