COURT ORDER

Gov. Greitens's Motion for Temporary Stay of Certain Grand Jury Proceedings is denied as moot and without prejudice based on representations by the Circuit Attorney's Office that the evidence will be reviewed by a party independent of the CAO. Once a special prosecutor is selected, the Circuit Attorney and the CAO are prohibited from any further involvement in this matter except to serve as witnesses in the case.

The Court orders that if any decision is made to present evidence to the grand jury in this matter, such decision will be made by and the presenter will be an individual independent of and not employed by the CAO.

If the outlined process is deviated from, the Court will re-evaluate whether the Motion to Stay is moot.
