What is FUSRAP?

The Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program is an environmental remediation program.

The FUSRAP team devotes itself to finding and remediating radiological contamination generated by activities of the Manhattan Engineer District and the Atomic Energy Commission (MED/AEC) during development of the atomic weapons in the 1940s and 1950s.

- Areas of **low-level** radioactive contamination may exist that do **not** pose a health risk if left **undisturbed**
