APPLICATION

I, [REDACTED] (hereinafter "Applicant"), BEING DULY SWORN,
hereby apply to this Court for an order pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 2703(c)(3), 3122, 3123
and 3124, authorizing the installation and monitoring of a pen register and/or trap and
trace device and/or caller identification and directing [REDACTED] and any other
telecommunications providers to provide to agents of the **Metropolitan Police**
Department, City of St. Louis (SLMPD) [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] (hereinafter "Agencies"), upon oral or
written request by such agents, the following telecommunications records and assistance
pertaining to cellular/wireless phone number [REDACTED] and any other phone numbers
associated with this account for the period of 30 days prior to [REDACTED] and
extending sixty (60) days past the date of such Order:

1. Cell site activations;
2. Numbers dialed;
3. Incoming numbers if identified;
4. Subscriber, ESN (Electronic serial number), and/or MEID, and/or MSID, and/or IMSI, and/or IMEI, and billing information for the specified cellular/wireless telephone;
5. Call durations;
6. Subscriber, ESN, and/or MEID, and/or MSID, and/or IMSI, and/or IMEI, and billing information for any other cellular/wireless telephones on this account or that may be identified from these records;
7. The physical address/location of all cellular towers in the specified market;
8. Call detail records in an electronic format specified by any agent of the aforementioned Agencies; and
9. Twenty-four hour a day assistance to include switch based solutions including precision location pursuant to probable cause based information queries and all reasonable assistance to permit the aforementioned Agencies to triangulate target location, including but not limited to terminating interfering service on the target telephone.

It is further requested pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2703(d), that [REDACTED] and/or any other telecommunications providers provide the aforementioned Agencies with subscriber information including names, addresses, credit and billing information of the subscribers, both published and non-published, for the telephone numbers dialing or being dialed from the cellular/wireless phone number, for

the period of 30 days prior to [REDACTED] to the present and extending (60) days past the date of this Order.

It is further requested that this Court's Order (a) direct [REDACTED] and its resellers not to terminate or restrict service to any cellular/wireless telephone covered by this Order for the duration of the Order; (b) cover and be applied to any cellular/wireless Mobile identification number (MIN) or electronic serial number (ESN) that the subscribers of the phones covered by this Order may change service to for the duration of this Order; (c) direct [REDACTED] and its resellers to furnish the aforementioned Agencies with all information, facilities and technical assistance necessary to accomplish the installation and use of a pen register and or a trap and trace device without geographical limitations unobtrusively and with a minimum of interference with the services of the person and/or party with respect to whom the installation and use is to take place.

In support of this application, Applicant deposes and states as follows:

I, [REDACTED], currently assigned to the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department [REDACTED], received information that victim [REDACTED] had his cellular phone stolen during a Murder 1st at [REDACTED].

On [REDACTED] at approximately [REDACTED] AM, District [REDACTED] officers received an assignment for a shooting at [REDACTED]. The Officers responded to the vacant house at [REDACTED] and located victim [REDACTED]. He directed the Officers to the second floor of the residence where victims [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were discovered. Both victims were conscious and suffering

from puncture wounds to the chest and neck. Neither victim could provide a statement as to what transpired.

EMS responded and conveyed victim [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] Hospital. Victim [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased by Dr. [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] am.

EMS responded and conveyed victim [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] Hospital. The victim evidenced a gunshot wound to the [REDACTED]. He was listed in serious/stable condition by Dr. [REDACTED].

An interview of victim [REDACTED] discovered that the victims had responded to the [REDACTED] address with the purpose of selling narcotics to the suspects. One suspect displayed an aluminum ball bat and struck victims [REDACTED] in the lower extremities. [REDACTED] fell to the ground and overheard the suspects announce a robbery. During this a suspect pulled a long barreled firearm and began firing shots at the victims. [REDACTED] was able to flee the residence through a second floor window and later discovered the other victims had been shot.

During this incident victim [REDACTED] disclosed his cellular phone had been stolen.

The stolen cell phone has service provided through [REDACTED] and the active number is [REDACTED].

It is critical that the above mentioned agencies be able to monitor the movements of the "Target Cellular Telephone" thereby assisting in locating the suspect(s) involved in this incident. Your affiant believes that requested authorization would be a valuable asset in achieving the overall goals in this investigation. The details of this incident are documented per St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department complaint numbers [REDACTED].

Applicant is a "State investigative or law enforcement officer" as used in Title 18, United States Code, Section 3122, and may apply for disclosure of telecommunications records.

Applicant certifies that the information sought is relevant and material to an investigation, to wit: **The target cellular phone service is still active and** and by using the phone it is believed that the requested telecommunications records will assist the aforementioned Agencies in the location and apprehension of said offenders.

Applicant requests that this Application and Order be sealed by the Court and that [REDACTED] and any other telecommunications related carrier and its agents and employees be directed not to disclose the existence of this Order or of this investigation to the subscriber or to any other person unless otherwise directed by the Court as such disclosure would seriously jeopardize this investigation.

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully requested that this Court enter its order (1) authorizing the installation and monitoring of a pen register and/or trap and trace device and/or caller identification and for the production of telecommunications records; and (2) sealing this application and the Court's Order.
