To build truly inclusive playgrounds where children — and adults — of all abilities can play and learn together in a fun and welcoming environment.

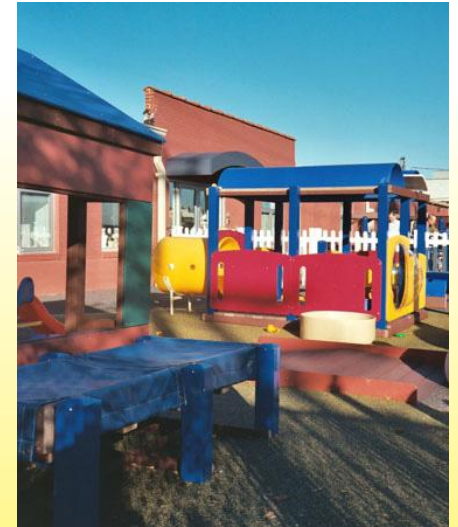
- **Our Vision:**

- Music & Touch area for sensory development
- Teen Fitness Area
- Planters with plant identification

Playground Budget Breakdown

Item	Cost
Playground equipment (including fitness/benches, etc.)	\$287,678.57
Poured in Place Rubber Surfacing	\$ 54,661.12
Concrete	\$ 50,000.00
Landscaping	\$ 15,000.00
Wood Fiber	\$ 4,856.40
Freight/Dumpster Rental	\$ 12,313.45
Installation	\$ 12,747.00
Projected Project Total	\$437,256.54

*Bid does not include site work or offloading.



JSC Fundraising Commitment

- Our Fundraising Goal is \$450,000
- So far, we've raised \$375,000
