Resolution of Censure

This Resolution of Censure made and entered into the minutes of the Kirkwood School District (hereinafter "the District" or "KSD") this ______ day of _____, 2020 by the Board of Education of the District upon motion and second, and approval by a majority vote, recites as follows:

WHEREAS Board of Education member Julie Backer (hereinafter "Backer") is a member of the Board of Education of the District and is subject to the Board Policies of the District including BBF and BDC and agreed upon internal Board Norms; and

WHEREAS Backer has willfully violated Board of Education Policies BBF and BDC and internal Board Norms to the detriment of the District; and

WHEREAS the Board of Education has voted to enter this Resolution of Censure to admonish Backer and inform the public that Backer is openly and willfully not complying with Board of Education Policies and Board Norms to the detriment of the District; and

WHEREAS the Board of Education believes that if the behavior and open defiance of Board of Education Policies is allowed to continue, there will be additional harm to the District; and

WHEREAS the Board of Education believes that Backer has violated Kirkwood Board of Education Policies to the detriment of the District as follows:

- Backer violated Board of Education Policy BBF, Board Ethics, Rule 3, "Recognize that individual Board members have no authority to speak for or act for the Board," and Board of Education Policy BBF, Board Ethics, Rule 11, "Support the employment of staff members based on qualifications and not as a result of influence" and Board of Education Policy BBF, Board Ethics, Rule 5 "Delegate authority for the administration of the schools to the Superintendent," in that:
 - a) In Fall 2016, Backer met with the Superintendent and misrepresented that she spoke for Member Frost and another Member, and requested that the Superintendent leave the position a year early on his contract without any authorization of Board Member Frost or the Board;
 - b) In 2018, after the Board agreed to hire a Superintendent, Backer met with the new Superintendent and stated to him that "if he didn't take care of a certain administrator, he would have a short stay at Kirkwood;"
 - c) In 2018, Backer stated to District Administrators that it was her intention to "make the new Superintendent [her] bitch," and such statements were among reasons recounted by the Superintendent as justification for refusing to honor his contract;
 - d) In 2018, in text messages with Administration personnel, Backer stated that "there's a new sheriff in town and it's called the board of education, watch out ASC serious changes coming down!!" In response to the Administration personnel stating that "I thought they were great. We are all excited."

Backer responded with "Haha well we will see how "excited" everyone is when they realize that they're not in charge anymore";

- e) In the January 30, 2020, High School PPO meeting, after hearing a public explanation of the process of interviewing Superintendent candidates and then making a decision on a new superintendent, Backer disagreed stating to the crowd, "I don't know about that, we'll see how the interviews go," she had previously stated to Board Member Frost and in defiance of previously defined Board consensus, that an in-house administrator should be added to the list of finalists so that he could be appointed, despite the fact that he had not applied for the position;
- f) Prior to the January 30, 2020, High School PPO Meeting, Backer interacted with a District employee who was supporting the District on an issue that Backer disagreed with, stating that the employee needed to be "scared of [her]." The employee perceived the statement as a threat. The employee has reported the incident and has sought independent legal counsel; and
- g) On January 28, 2019, Backer sent to the Superintendent a series of texts attempting to influence the Superintendent to declare a "snow day" badgering and lecturing the Superintendent for not paying attention to her at the same time the Superintendent was on conference calls with other Superintendents and weather experts.
- 2) Backer violated Board of Education Policy BBF, Board Ethics Rule 14, "Refrain from using their Board position for the benefit of family members, business associates, or themselves" and Board of Education Policy BBF, Board Ethics, Rule 13 "Avoid conflicts of Interest or the appearance thereof," in that:
 - a) On October 31, 2018, the attorney for the Special School District ("SSD") wrote to the District about the practice of Backer appearing at IEP meetings of unrelated children, announcing that she was a KSD Board member and taking a position adverse to KSD knowing that she was in a position of conflict and could be called as a witness in a resulting US District Court lawsuit against KSD. At the time she served as the KSD representative on the SSD Board as well, so her conflict was further increased. She was alleged to be offering her services as political muscle due to her KSD Board position;
 - b) On January 3, 2019, the District was alerted by the Principal of an Elementary School that a parent intended to bring Backer to a meeting with the Principal concerning academic and/or behavioral issues. At the same time, that same Principal, who had interim status, was interviewing for a full-time position that would be decided by the Board;
 - c) On December 18, 2018, the Superintendent received an email from a citizen who was concerned because Backer had represented to a prospective house buyer in Kirkwood who was looking at a home in which Backer was working for as the listing real estate agent, that she could get the buyer's child "an exception to place the child in another elementary school;"
 - d) In February 2018, Backer approached the incoming superintendent on a visit to the District after he signed his contract and proposed that he use her

as his real estate agent followed by uncomfortable emails pursuing the listing which "interfered with his relocation plans." This was another reason cited by the new Superintendent for not honoring his contract; and

- e) In March 2018, Backer contacted an Elementary School Principal directly using her status as a Board Member requested FERPA and HIPPA protected information of a child at the school. When the Principal correctly refused, Backer first complained to the Superintendent, and then in an open session of the Board of Education four days later, publicly and unjustly criticized the Principal using personal professional disparagements. The severity of the behavior caused the Superintendent to stop Principals from making reports to the Board to protect the Principals.
- Backer violated Board of Education Policy BBF, Board Ethics Rule 16 and Board of Education Policy BDC, Closed Meeting, Records and Votes, "Refrain from divulging confidential information presented during closed sessions" in that:
 - a) On October 1, 2019, after learning from the Superintendent that she had been diagnosed with an illness and was exercising her contractual right to retire at the end of the 2019-2020 school year, the Board agreed in closed session to hold the news until scheduled announcement dates, and to refrain from disclosing the medical diagnosis out of courtesy to the Superintendent who was going into treatment. Thereafter, Backer requested a meeting and later texted to an Administrator, who had not been present in the closed session, disclosing the news about the Superintendent. She stated that the closed session information had also been shared with a Principal. Backer discussed and then texted the administrator discussing district level administrator positions for the same Principal. Backer stated that she wanted the Principal to get the Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent for HR position and wanted the Administrator to present the proposition to the current Superintendent. After being admonished Backer flippantly dismissed the need for discretion and told the administrator to "delete these texts." Backer requested to be let in the back door of ASC to avoid detection, and then lied about the meeting when confronted by the full Board.
- 4) Backer violated Board of Education Policy BBF, Board Ethics, Rule 15, "Express personal opinion but once the Board has acted, accept the will of the majority" and Board of Education Policy BBF, Board Ethics, Rule 5, "Delegate authority for the administration of the schools to the superintendent" in that:
 - a) On July 25, 2018, after the decision had been made to not retain a company, an organization that employed a social friend of Backer, Backer appeared at a Wellness Committee meeting and publicly berated the Superintendent in disrespectful and degrading personal attack that one employee who was present described as a "5 year old child who didn't get her way." The July 25th meeting was recorded by an employee of the district as a tool to help create accurate minutes. That employee is also a friend and/or ally of Backer. After that employee's supervisor asked for the recording several

times and told the employee not to delete the recording, the employee deleted the recording anyway, which resulted in disciplinary action against that employee.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Education enters this Order of Censure, admonishing Julie Backer for willfully violating Board of Education Policies BBF and BDC to the detriment of the Kirkwood School District and informing the public that Julie Backer's behavior is in willful defiance of Board of Education Policies to the detriment of the Kirkwood School District.

Re: SSD/General: Board Member at IEP Meeting

Dear Mr. Leonard:

I am writing on behalf of the Special School District of St. Louis County (SSD). It has come to the SSD's attention that a member of the Board of Education of the Kirkwood R-VII School District (Kirkwood) has attended one or more IEP or other team meetings at the request of the parent. SSD unquestioningly recognizes a parent's right to invite individuals with knowledge or special expertise regarding the child, including a board member of a component district, to attend IEP meetings. 34 C.F.R. § 300.324(a)(6). However, the District is also aware that IEP teams should be insulated from undue influence by boards of education. For that reason, members of SSD's Board of Education refrain from attending IEP meetings.

The concern of SSD is that it is informed that the Kirkwood board member announces her board status – both as a member of the Board of Education of the Kirkwood R-VII School District and as a member of the Governing Council of the Special School District. As you are aware, a member of a school district board of education, who does not have the authority of that board to speak on its behalf, is simply an invitee of the parent. Unless Kirkwood informs SSD that the board member is attending the IEP/other team meeting at the direction of the Board of Education of the Kirkwood R-VII School District, SSD will assume that the board member has no "board member status" at the IEP/other team meeting.

With this in mind, SSD respectfully requests that Kirkwood clarify whether the board member in question – Kirkwood's representative on SSD's Governing Council – is acting at the direction of the Board of Education of the Kirkwood R-VII School District. If so, we would encourage the Kirkwood Board to reconsider, and caution that the board member can attend only if invited by the parent. If not, should the board member attend IEP/other team meetings in the future, SSD will inform the IEP team members that the board member is acting without the authority of the Board of Education of the Kirkwood R-VII School District and is a private citizen attending at the request of the parent. SSD will require that the parent sign the appropriate releases permitting SSD to share information with the parent invitee and will inform the

parent that the confidentiality provisions that typically attach to school officials may not attach to private citizens.

I appreciate your attention to this matter.

I have been diligently following the board norms around staff-board communication since they were adopted. I do not reach out to board members without your permission and I funnel all information requests through you. I am uncomfortable with the fact that not all of us in the cabinet are following the norms and I believe it has led to some having the opportunity to have stronger relationships with our board than others. This is the first time I am expressing this concern.

Secondly, when recalling the previous superintendent search, our internal candidates were not given the same opportunities of a confidential process that other candidates recieved. Whatever breakdown in the process occurred that leaked candidate information negatively affected those involved. In particular, one person almost had his family torn apart due to accusations that were made anonymously and outside of our district procedures. No one deserves to endure that when the process should have been strictly confidential.

To be transparent, and I talked about his interest in an HR position back in the spring during a career discussion. I often ask our staff what their future interests are so I can make them aware of opportunties that may be suited to their personal plans. I have a good relationship with and want his talents to be utilized and for him to enjoy his job. Many people know. is eligble to retire and we spoke briefly about the future if she were to then that I was always interested in the benefits position because it allows you to work with poeple retire. I tok in their time of need - usually due to health conditions. He expressed that he may be interested in a future in HR as this was around the time he was interviewing init He also knows and I shared works at recently with him and that if retires I would be interested in the benefits position because I was struggling to find care for during all of our Monday evening events. He never said definitively that he was interested in an HR job.

I have had my integrity unjustly called into question over the past few months and so I am respectfully requesting to not be involved in the superintedents search for any purpose other than to provide factual information.

I support and believe that he has many strengths, however, it is not my job to select the Superintendent. I am confident that the Board will select the best person to lead our district. However, I am fearful as the friend that he might endure the same accusations that were made previously and I cannot be involved in a process that is not going

to be confidential for the protection of all the candidates. After the conversations this week, I am very concerned that we are already headed down that path again. Our candidates and their families do not deserve that.

I am requesting protection for my employment under District policy GBCBB. I was asked by my employer to recall two encounters with Ms. Julie Backer. Ms. Julie Backer is a board of education director and has the ability to negatively affect my employment. As noted below, she has stated that she would fire someone in order to hire someone she is more supportive of. Ms. Backer has threatened staff for talking about her in the lunch room and the members of ASC.

The following is my recollection of a conversation held in my office with Julie Backer on October 23, 2019.

Julie contacted me asking if she could stop by. She stated that she used the copy center entrance so no one would see her walk in. She wanted to discuss **Sector State Control** future as superintendent. On Monday, Dr. Condon had announced her retirement to the BOE and also stated my desire to move to the director position, thus opening the head HR job. I told Julie that I didn't want to be involved in the search after what happened with the anonymous accusations during the last search. Those allegations almost destroyed his family and I didn't want my name associated with any process that can't be confidential.

Julie stated that Chad had already met with the since Monday and told him that he did not have four votes to be superintendent. Thank you for the opportunity to talk with you today regarding possible training for your board as it begins the process of creating a new governance team with Dr. Arnett.

As we discussed, it may be best to hold the training after the April election; please know that the members of the Leadership Development department (Phyllis Barks; Dr. Patty Polster, and I) have placed a hold on our calendars for the following dates: April 14; April 28; and May 5. Once the board decides on which date would work best, we will work with you to finalize the presenters and time frame for the training.

Research is clear that there is a positive correlation between effective school board governance and increased student performance. At the core of effective governance practices is having a positive relationship with the superintendent, which includes having a clear understanding of the roles and responsibilities of the superintendent, administrators, staff and the board.
