#### **CONTEST RULES**

- 1. The Contest will have 2 categories, Youth, 7-13 years and Adult 14 years & up.
- 2. There will be a \$2.00 entry fee to compete.
- 3. Entries will be limited to the first 15 contestants in each category.
- 4. All contestants must be registered and checked in at the Information Booth by 7 p.m. on July 4th.
- 5. The object is to eat as many hot dogs and buns with water as the only beverage. Water will be provided to all contestants.
- 6. Each contestant will be given 6 hot dogs.
- 7. Condiments such as mustard and ketchup will be provided if desired.
- 8. Contestants will wait for the signal to start and a stopwatch will be used.
- 9. The allotted time is five (5) minutes. 10. Any complete hot dog and bun in the competitor's mouth at the whistle, counts toward the final tally.
- 11. Dunking and crunching the hot dog and bun is allowed.
- 12. Separating the hot dog and bun to eat them individually is allowed, however to count toward finality, both have to be consumed or in competitor's mouth at whistle.
- 13. Throwing up during the contest disqualifies and ends the competition for the contestant
- 13. Contestants must not touch any hot dogs until the starting signal.
- 14. Winner will be determined by whoever finishes within the best tine OR whoever has eaten the most hot dogs within the allotted time.
- 15. The judges will determine the winner of the contest not the participants & the judges' decision will be final.
- 16. Any contestant caught breaking any of the above rules will be disqualified.
