SUMMARY ORDINANCE NO. 121-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PRIOR LAKE, MINNESOTA ANNEXING LAND LOCATED IN SPRING LAKE TOWNSHIP, SCOTT COUNTY, MINNESOTA PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES § 414.033 SUBDIVISION 2 (3), PERMITTING ANNEXATION BY ORDINANCE

The following is only a summary of Ordinance No. 121-07. The full text will be available for public inspection after July 3rd, 2021 by any person during regular office hours at City Hall or in the Document Center on the City of Prior Lake Website.

SUMMARY: The corporate limits of the City of Prior Lake, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the following described property, said land abutting the City of Prior Lake and being 120 acres or less in area, and is not presently served by public sewer facilities or public sewer facilities are not otherwise available, and the City having received a petition for annexation from all the property owners of the land, to wit:

The South 662.41 feet of the East Half of the West Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 12, Township 114, Range 22, Scott County Minnesota. Subject to an easement for road and utility purposes over, under and across the South 33.00 feet of the above-described property. Also subject to an easement for road and utility purposes over, under and across

that part of the above-described property lying East of a line 33.00 feet West of the center line of Scott County Road Number 87, Scott County, Minnesota. (PID: 119120042)
