We should probably dial in our agenda a bit. This will help line up the right players.

1. I am guessing the angle you're most interested in is the near-term coordination for on-site activities and submittals with off-site infrastructure build-out but let us know what you want to hit on.
2. We are still dialing in our end of water supply based on the most recent ramp-up projections you all shared. I do not think we will have anything ready to discuss this topic further.

3. I think a major input that we would like confirmation on from you all is Day 1 + Day N framework (what we've built previous discussions and agreements around) vs the updated delivery discussion of skipping over Day 1 and focusing on constructing Day N from the start. 4. Termination of Day N line into your pump station, coordination with entrance road work.
5. The development agreement draft is still in your team's court.
6. We can discuss the heat recovery concept in more detail, but I think that makes more sense to hold until Thursday group + your Sustainability Team.
