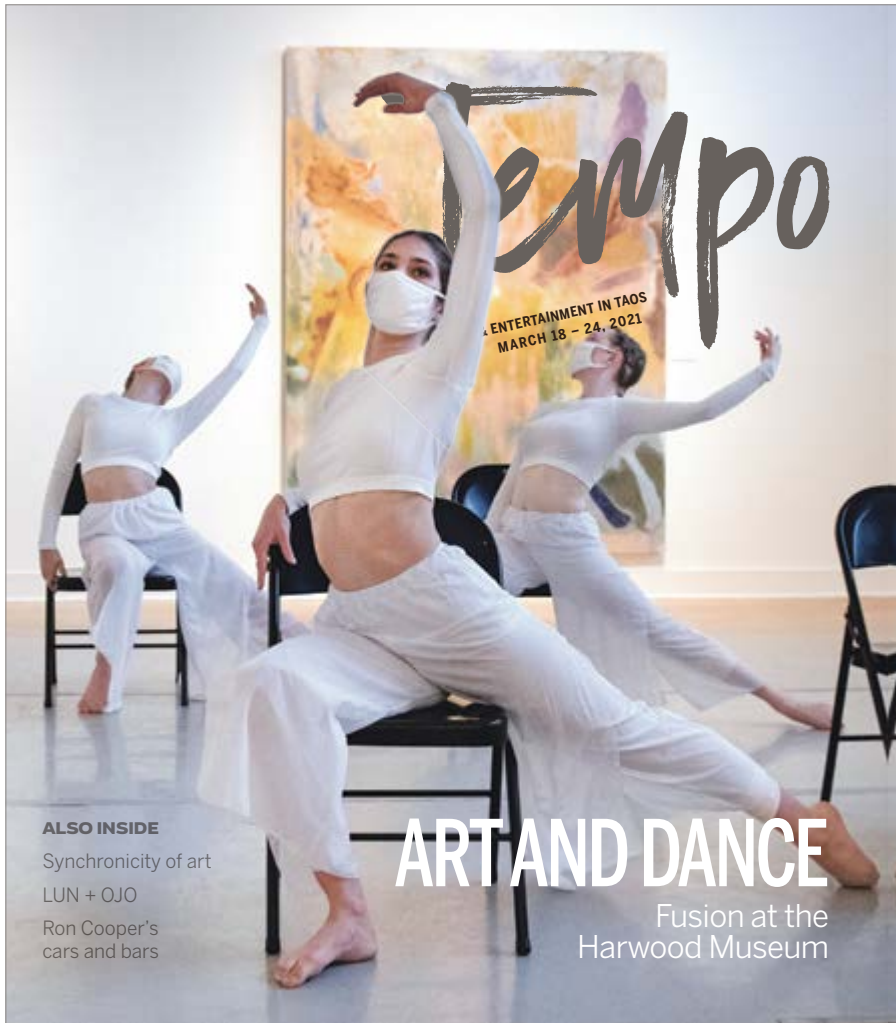




Tempo is where Taos goes for art, entertainment and culture.
