Dear Mayor Davis and Council Members,

We are writing to you today as members of the community to address the recent approval of the 11 data centers within our municipality, which have been permitted to proceed without comprehensive environmental, economic, or infrastructure impact studies.

Because the long-term well-being of our neighborhoods, resources, and infrastructure is at stake, we are formally preparing to file an injunction to halt these developments until the necessary impact studies can be thoroughly conducted and evaluated.

We want to be entirely clear: our goal is not to create an adversarial relationship with our local representatives. We genuinely do not want to work against the people elected to lead and protect our community, and we hope you feel the same way toward the residents you serve.

If these developments are a result of intense pressure or mandates from the state level, we want you to know that you do not have to navigate this alone. We would deeply appreciate your help, transparency, and partnership in this matter. We can handle this challenge together as a unified community.

This is the exact same request that we brought before you on February 26, 2026. Our position has not changed, but our urgency has grown. We respectfully ask that you reconsider the current trajectory of these projects and join hands with the community to ensure our local environment and infrastructure are fully protected.

Thank you for your time, your service, and your attention to this critical matter. We look forward to your response and hope to find a collaborative path forward.
