Nature of Proceedings:		Order Granting Petitioner's Ex Parte Application Filed July 10, 2025	

On July 10, 2025, Petitioner filed an ex parte application to expedite the hearing date for its motion for leave to file a supplemental complaint currently scheduled for August 15. Petitioner seeks to expedite the hearing to August 6 or earlier in order to comply with an applicable statute of limitation for a new claim sought to be included in the supplemental complaint. Respondent filed a response stating that it does not oppose specially setting an expedited hearing on the motion so long as it is given the applicable statutory notice periods.

The ex parte application is granted without a hearing. The hearing on Petitioner's motion for leave to file a supplemental complaint is expedited to August 4, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. Any briefs related to the motion must comply with the deadlines for law and motion matters under Code of Civil Procedure section 1005, subdivision (b).
