## ELK HUNTING REGULATIONS CHANGE PROPOSAL

To all interested and affected parties:

This is to provide you with advanced notice of proposed regulatory change regarding California Code of Regulations Title 14 Sections 364 Elk Hunting and 364.1 SHARE Elk Hunting, and to invite you to provide public comment during the Wildlife Resources Committee meeting on September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

The proposed 364 Elk Hunting and 364.1 SHARE Elk Hunting changes include:

- Increasing the bull tag quota in the Northwestern Roosevelt Elk Hunt Zone (Humboldt and Del Norte counties)
- Increasing the antlerless tag quota and adjusting the bull season dates in the Siskiyou Roosevelt Elk Hunt Zone (Siskiyou County)
- Modifying the boundaries of the Cache Creek Tule Elk Hunt Zone and the Bear Valley Tule Elk Hunt Zone (Lake, Colusa, and Yolo counties)
- Establishing a new Central Coast Tule Elk General Methods Hunt and Hunt Zone boundary (Monterey and San Luis Obispo counties), establishing a new Gabilan Tule Elk General Methods Hunt and Hunt Zone boundary (San Benito, Monterey, Fresno, and Kings counties), and modifying the boundaries of the La Panza Tule Elk Hunt Zone (San Luis Obispo, Kern, and Kings counties)
- Establishing a new Tehachapi Rocky Mountain Elk General Methods Hunt and Hunt Zone boundary (Kern County)

The proposed regulation changes are intended to satisfy goals and objectives as outlined in the [2018 Elk Conservation and Management Plan](#).

Opportunity for public participation and to provide public comment will occur at the Fish and Game Commission Wildlife Resources Committee meeting held on September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022, in Los Angeles, or by joining the teleconference remotely.
