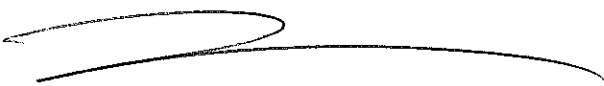

The family of Alton Sterling formally request that their attorneys of record be allowed to review the audio and video surveillance that was verbally discussed with the family at the DOJ meeting. As your office continues to investigate the matter for any potential criminal violations there is an immediate need to review these files. This in no way interferes with your investigation. In many cases family and their legal representatives are allowed to review footage in person while being investigated, yet this has not happened in the Sterling case. There is no legal basis to not allow a private review of the requested footage. We hope that this request can be granted immediately.
