The name of the accused is Everett Gauthier, Senior (deceased). The Diocese of Baton Rouge is prepared to offer immediate outreach and compassionate assistance.

As your Bishop, with deep sadness, I must inform you that an allegation of sexual abuse has been made against a member of the clergy serving St. Thomas More parish during the early to mid-1970s. The victim is uncertain of the identity of perpetrator. This allegation is being taken seriously and is being investigated.
