I write this letter to thank you personally for your continued participation in the democratic process. My primary goal as Louisiana's chief elections officer is to ensure the security of our elections and the integrity of your vote.

To that end, I want to assure you that your enrollment and participation in the absentee-by-mail ballot program for citizens 65 years of age and older is protected by state election laws. My office and your parish registrar of voters will never disclose that you are enrolled in the program, and state law prohibits voter harassment, coercion or intimidation by candidates or third parties.

If, at any time, you feel that you are being harassed, coerced or intimidated by a candidate or a third party to cast your absentee ballot a certain way, or because of your enrollment in the 65 and older absentee-by-mail ballot program, please call the Secretary of State's Elections Compliance Unit at 800.722.5305.

Again, thank you for exercising your right to vote, one of our most fundamental rights as Americans. Please feel free to contact my office should you need assistance in the future.
