

Entrance

Cajun Field gates will open one hour prior to each commencement ceremony. Each graduate is allotted only 4 tickets for their graduation ceremony. Every person, regardless of age, must have a ticket and a face covering to enter the premises.

Clear Bag Policy Information

The following bags will be permitted inside Cajun Field and are subject to search:

- Clear storage bag: 1 quart.
 - Clear clutch or small purse, with or without strap, many not exceed 6.5' by 4.5" by 1".
 - Diaper bags for age-appropriate children accompanied by an adult.
 - Equipment bags necessary for medical items.

Seating

Social distancing will be practiced and family groups will be spaced six feet apart. There is no assigned seating for family, everyone will be directed by Cajundome staff and seated as they arrive on a first come first serve basis.

Concessions

No outside food or drinks are allowed to be brought in to Cajun Field. Bottled water will be available for purchase.

Parking

Families: We are asking that family groups ride together in one vehicle to the graduation ceremony as parking will be very limited. Family groups are to enter the Cajun Field parking lot through Gate 4 off of Congress Street and enter into Cajun Field through Gates C or D. Handicapped parking is available adjacent to the reserved parking lot off of Cajundome Boulevard. Vehicles may enter the Cajun Field parking lot through Gate 4 on West Congress Street, and enter Cajun Field through Gates C or D.

Graduates: All graduates must enter Cajun Field from the Reindhart Drive entrance and must have on their graduation cap and gown to gain entrance in to the facility. If driving, graduates only, will be allowed to park in the reserved parking lot. Faculty will be located near the entrance to line up the graduates and hand them their face masks.

Stay Safe Guidelines

Please note, students have been given detailed instructions from their individual schools, with the goal of having a safe graduation experience. Graduates will be seated at an appropriate distance from their classmates and have been instructed to not congregate prior to or after the ceremonies. They have also been instructed to return to their vehicles as soon as the graduation ceremony is over. Therefore guests are advised to take photographs off-site with graduates before or after the ceremonies.
