Dear Mr. Latino:

In accordance with the terms of this letter, we are providing you with authorization to bring a live tiger to Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College for a pregame presentation immediately prior to the LSU v. Alabama football game.

This authorization is conditioned upon the following:

1. Complete cooperation with the football operations staff regarding logistics.
2. Presentation of a certificate of insurance naming the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University as an additional insured with a minimum total coverage of three million dollars.
3. The tiger must always be accompanied by a trained handler while it is on campus.
4. You or the vendor will maintain all necessary permits/licenses for possession of an exotic animal.
5. The understanding that the university may cancel the presentation of the tiger at any time in the event of unforeseen events that would jeopardize the football game or safety of staff or fans (i.e. inclement weather affecting field conditions, civil unrest, etc.)

The university is prepared to provide you and your team accompanying the tiger with the following:

1. A secure indoor climate-controlled location sufficient to house the tiger in its cage beginning on November 7 through November 11.
2. Escort to and from the storage location to the stadium on game day.
3. Credentials to access the stadium for presentation of the tiger.
