



Which of the seven state issues, if improved, would most enhance your quality of life right now?






Pocketbooks are top of mind for Louisianans right now, and this carries consistently across all demographics.




Do you support giving families the ability to choose a public school that works best for their child?

When it comes to keeping children safe online, Louisianans unambiguously feel parents and families should bear the greatest responsibility.




Republicans at 64% are most likely to cite parents and families as the ultimate responsible party.

### State Government






### Insurance & Legal Reform

#### **Lawsuit Abuse Increases Cost**




3 out of 4 voters said their insurance premiums increased over the last year.

# Elected Official Approval
