Happy to provide additional info here.

As part of the fall 2021 and spring 2022 costing exercises, Turner/Hunt worked with Gensler and our construction manager over the course of months to do a deep dive on the building condition and potential updates under consideration at the time. They spent time onsite and offsite, met with building staff, met with consultants, etc. In addition to the eight-page architectural drawings you've already seen, the <u>document linked here</u> was the "latest and greatest," most recent and comprehensive Gensler work product we gave to Turner during its costing exercise.

Also, as a part of my tracking down the documents you requested with respect to the Turner review, I learned over the weekend that after our initial deliverable to VSG in early August, a few weeks later our construction manager gave VSG the <u>same Gensler materials</u> as a supplement to the eight-page architectural drawings in our initial delivery.

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Mr. Chairman,

The document I provided to you is the full documentation provided by the Titans at VSG's request regarding the proposed Gensler renovation. To be clear, there isn't a "Gensler Plan" document. Our client worked with Gensler for two years developing stadium update and renovation possibilities and during that time traded hundreds of documents and ideas. In late fall 2021, our client asked contractors to assist in providing cost estimates on the concepts being considered, as well as any enabling, infrastructure-type work to bring the stadium back to first-class condition. The document we provided VSG, and you earlier this week, represents a full site map of all concepts under consideration for the seven floors of the stadium in fall 2021.

As for the key, forgive me if I'm wrong about this (I'm not an architect or construction manager), but I do not believe the key ties to another resource but rather maps to the concepts reflected on the site map. For example, "003 EAST CONCOURSE" ties to a concept noted on the L2 (Level 2) MAIN CONCOURSE page.

As you pointed out, the language referenced in Manhattan Construction's letter does not appear in that document, and we are unsure where it may have come from.
