Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Genesee County Economic Development Center (GCEDC) STAMP Edwards Infrastructure Contract 2-Stub Road Extension** will be received, by the **Genesee County Economic Development Center** , at the office of the **Genesee County Economic Development Center (GCEDC) 99 MedTech Drive, Suite 106, Batavia, New York 14020** , until **2:00 p.m.** local time on **July 29, 2025** , at which time the Bids received will be **publicly** opened and read aloud. **This project involves the grading, stormwater and construction of approximately 950 linear feet of new roadway to provide access to the new Edward Vacuum Facility.** Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price and lump sum basis, as indicated in the Bid Form. If necessary, an Addendum will be issued by **12:00 p.m.** (Local Time) on **July 25, 2025** from the office of the Engineer. Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Each bid must be accompanied by a certified bank check or bid bond from a domestic carrier licensed to do business in the State of New York in the amount of not less than five (5%) of the amount of the bid submitted. **This Contract is partially funded by Empire State Development (ESD). The ESD has established an overall goal of 30% for Minority Women-Owned Business Enterprise (M/WBE) participation. All M/WBEs utilized must be in the NY State Certified MWBE directory found at the following internet address: https://ny.newnycontracts.com . If Contractor is unable to meet the 30% goal, Contractor is required to document “good faith efforts” to provide meaningful participation of WMBEs as subcontractors or suppliers in the performance of this Contract. After the Contract has been awarded and before the Agreement can be executed, the Contractor will be required to submit all such documentation including copies of executed Agreements with subcontractors and /or suppliers, as well as “good faith efforts.”** Minority and Women’s Business Enterprises are encouraged to apply. Contract Award will also emphasize MWBE participation in accordance with New York State Executive Law Article 15-A and 5 NYCRR Parts 142-144 (“MWBE Regulations”). Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President’s Executive Order Nos. 11,246 and 11,375 which prohibit discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin. The successful bidder must be an equal opportunity employer, must meet all appropriate State and Federal standards, and comply with all relevant governmental regulations. **Statement of Non-Collusion: Bidders on the contract are required to execute a non-collusive bidding certificate pursuant to Section 103d of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York. Security for Faithful Performance: The successful bidder will be required to furnish Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds written by firms licensed to do business in New York State, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amounts in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. Sales and Use of Tax Exemptions: The GCEDC is exempt from the payment of sales and compensation use taxes of the State of New York and of cities and counties on all materials, equipment, and supplies sold to the GCEDC pursuant to this contract. Also exempt from such taxes are purchases by the Contractor and his Subcontractors of materials, equipment, and supplies to be sold to the GCEDC pursuant to this contract, including tangible personal property to be incorporated in any structure, building, or other real property forming part of the project. These taxes are not to be included in the Bid. All Bids must be accompanied by the contractor's Certificate of Registration. All bids shall be binding for a period of sixty (60) days after the bid opening date. PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on July 8, 2025, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Holley, in the County of Orleans, New York, adopted a bond resolution entitled: “Bond Resolution of the Village of Holley, New York, adopted July 8, 2025, authorizing the issuance of bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$1,400,000 to finance the construction of improvements to the Village Wastewater Treatment Plant (Phase 2), stating the estimated maximum cost thereof is \$1,400,000 and appropriating said amount for such purpose,” an abstract of such bond resolution, concisely stating the purpose and effect thereof, being as follows:
FIRST: AUTHORIZING the Village of Holley, New York to issue bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$1,400,000 pursuant to the Local Finance Law of the State of New York, to finance construction of improvements to the Village Wastewater Treatment Plant (Phase 2), substantially as described in the report prepared for the Village by Wendel, duly licensed engineers, dated May 2025;
SECOND: STATING that the estimated maximum cost thereof, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and the financing thereof, is \$1,400,000; APPROPRIATING said amount for such purpose; STATING that the plan of financing includes the issuance of bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$1,400,000 to finance said appropriation, and the levy and collection of assessments and/or taxes on all the taxable real property in the Village to pay the principal of said bonds and the interest thereon as the same shall become due and payable; and STATING that in the event that grant funds are received to pay a part of the cost of the project from federal, state or other sources, the principal amount of bonds issued shall be reduced by the amount of grant said grant funds;
THIRD: DETERMINING and STATING that the period of probable usefulness applicable to the purpose for which said bonds are authorized to be issued is forty (40) years; the proceeds of said bonds and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation thereof may be applied to reimburse the Village for expenditures made after the effective date of this bond resolution for the purpose for which said bonds are authorized; and the proposed maturity of said bonds will exceed five (5) years;
FOURTH: DETERMINING that said bonds and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds and the renewals of said bond anticipation notes shall be general obligations of the Village; and PLEDGING to their payment the faith and credit of the Village;
FIFTH: DELEGATING to the Village Treasurer the powers and duties as to the issuance of said bonds, and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds, or the renewals thereof;
SIXTH: STATING the conditions under which the validity of the bonds and any notes issued in anticipation thereof may be contested; and
SEVENTH: DETERMINING that the bond resolution is subject to a permissive referendum.
