Early mail and absentee ballot applications can be obtained during school business hours from the District Clerk. Applications must be returned at least seven (7) days prior to the vote if to be mailed to the voter or at least one (1) day prior to the vote if to be delivered in person to the voter in the Office of the District Clerk.
