NOTICE OF ANNUAL MEETING, BUDGET VOTE AND ELECTION
LETCHWORTH CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

Town of Gainesville, Counties of Wyoming & Allegany, New York

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Education of the Letchworth Central School District, Wyoming & Allegany Counties, Gainesville, New York, will hold a public hearing at Letchworth Central School, High School Cafeteria, on May 12, 2025, at 7:30 PM prevailing time for the presentation of the proposed budget for the 2025-2026 school year. Copies of the proposed budget with required attachments will be available for review by District residents beginning on May 6, 2025 at the District Office, the four local public libraries and online at www.letchworth.k12.ny.us/Departments/Business/Office.

NOTICE IS ALSO GIVEN that the Annual Budget Vote and District Election will be held at Letchworth Central School on May 23, 2025, between the hours of 12:00 Noon and 8:00 PM prevailing time in the Auditorium Lobby at Letchworth Central School, at which time the polls will be opened to vote upon the following:

- To adopt the annual budget of the School District for the fiscal year 2025-2026 and to authorize the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the District.
- To elect three (3) members of the Board of Education for a three (3) year term commencing July 1, 2025 and expiring on June 30, 2028 and to succeed: Merritt Broughton IV, Scott Kemp, Nick Youngers, whose terms expire on June 30, 2025.
- Shall the following resolution be adopted to wit: Resolved that the Board of Education of the Letchworth Central School District is hereby authorized to establish a Capital Reserve Fund pursuant to Section 3651 of the Education Law (to be known as the "2025 Transportation Vehicles Capital Reserve Fund"), with the purpose of such fund being to purchase vehicles for the transportation of students as part of the transportation program of the district, the ultimate amount of such fund to be \$950,000, plus earnings thereon, the probable term of such fund to be 10 years, but such fund shall continue in existence until liquidated in accordance with the Education Law or until the funds are exhausted, and the sources from which the funds shall be obtained for such Reserve are (i) an initial deposit of \$66,138 plus accrued interest to be transferred from the existing 2015 Maintenance Vehicle/Equipment Reserve Fund, and (ii) an initial deposit of \$50,000 to be transferred from the existing Unemployment Insurance Reserve, and (iii) amounts authorized by the voters from time to time, and (iv) unappropriated fund balance made available by the Board of Education from time to time, and (v) proceeds from the sale of retired vehicles, all to the extent permitted by law.
- Shall the following resolution be adopted to wit: Resolved that the Board of Education of the Letchworth Central School District is hereby authorized to establish a Capital Reserve Fund pursuant to Section 3651 of the Education Law (to be known as the "2025 Transportation Vehicles Capital Reserve Fund"), with the purpose of such fund being to purchase vehicles for the transportation of students as part of the transportation program of the district, the ultimate amount of such fund to be \$950,000, plus earnings thereon, the probable term of such fund to be 10 years, but such fund shall continue in existence until liquidated in accordance with the Education Law or until the funds are exhausted, and the sources from which the funds shall be obtained for such Reserve are (i) an initial deposit of \$66,138 plus accrued interest to be transferred from the existing 2015 Maintenance Vehicle/Equipment Reserve Fund, and (ii) an initial deposit of \$50,000 to be transferred from the existing Unemployment Insurance Reserve, and (iii) amounts authorized by the voters from time to time, and (iv) unappropriated fund balance made available by the Board of Education from time to time, and (v) proceeds from the sale of retired vehicles, all to the extent permitted by law.
- Shall the amount of funds raised by taxation to support the four public libraries in the Letchworth Central School District be increased from \$230,741.94 to \$243,096.12, the increased amount to be distributed as follows: \$36,100.18 to the Eagle Free Library, Ellicott; \$87,712.20 to the Cordelia A. Greene Library, Castile; \$67,687.61 to the Gainesville Public Library, Silver Springs; and \$51,595.93 to the Pikeville Association, Pike?

NOTICE IS ALSO GIVEN that petitions nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education shall be filed with the District Clerk during normal working hours, and not later than 5:00 PM on April 21, 2025. Each petition shall be directed to the District Clerk, shall be signed by at least 25 voters of the District, and must state the name and residence of the candidate. The candidates who receive a plurality of the votes cast respectively for the three (3) offices are to be declared elected.

NOTICE IS ALSO GIVEN that applications for early mail and absentee ballots may be obtained at the Office of the District Clerk or by calling the District Clerk 585-493-5450. Completed applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter at the Office of the District Clerk. Early mail and absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 PM, on May 20, 2025. A list of persons to whom early mail and absentee ballots have been issued will be available for inspection in the office of the District Clerk between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM between May 14, 2025 and May 19, 2025, except Saturday, May 17, 2025, by prearranged appointment only, and said list will be available at the polling place at the election.

NOTICE IS ALSO GIVEN that Military voters, as defined by Commissioner's regulation Part 122, who are qualified voters of the District, may apply for a military ballot during school business hours at the office of the District Clerk in person or by mail at Letchworth Central School District, 5550 School Rd., Gainesville, NY 14066, phone (585) 493-5450, or by email ewolfer@letchworth.k12.ny.us. A military voter may designate a preference to receive a military ballot application by mail, facsimile transmission or electronic mail in their request for such application. Completed applications for military ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 24, 2025. Ballots for military voters shall be mailed, or otherwise distributed, no later than 25 days prior to the election. Completed military ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 PM, on May 20, 2025.

NOTICE IS ALSO GIVEN that the qualified voters of the School District shall be entitled to vote on said Annual Budget Vote and District Election. A qualified voter is one who is (1) a citizen of the United States of America, (2) eighteen years of age or older, and (3) resident within the School District for a period of thirty (30) days preceding the annual vote and election. The School District may require all persons offering to vote to provide one form of proof of residency pursuant to Education Law 2018-c. Such form may include a driver's license, a non-driver identification card, a utility bill or a voter registration card. Upon offer of proof of residency, the School District shall also require all persons offering to vote to provide their signature, printed name and address.

NOTICE IS ALSO GIVEN that pursuant to a rule adopted by the Board of Education in accordance with §2035 and 2008 of the Education Law, and referenda or propositions to amend the budget, otherwise to be submitted for voting at said election, must be filed with the Letchworth Board of Education at the District Office on or before 5:00 PM on April 21, 2025, must be typed or printed in English, must be directed to the Clerk of the School District, and be signed by at least 25 qualified voters of the District and must state the name and residence of each signer. However, the School Board will not entertain any petition to place before the voters any proposition the purpose of which is not within the powers of the District, or any proposition which fails to include a specific appropriation where the expenditure of monies is required by the proposition.

NOTICE OF ANNUAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET HEARING AND VOTE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the annual budget hearing for the qualified voters of the Holley Central School District (the "District") on Tuesday, May 6, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. in District Office BOE Room at the Elementary School building on North Main Street in the Vill of Holley to present the proposed 2025-2026 budget.

AND NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the Annual School District Meeting: Vote of the District (the "Annual Meeting and Vote") will be held on Tuesday, May 20, 2025 at 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. in the main entrance foyer of the District's Middle/High School Building on Lynch Road for the following purposes: (1) electing four members of the Board of Education (the "Board"); (2) voting on the District's proposed budget for the 2025-2026 fiscal year; (3) voting on the purchase of replacement school buses; (4) raising funds for the Community Fund Library; and transacting such other business as authorized by law or rules of the Board.

AND NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the Board will have prepared: a completed a detailed statement in writing of the amount of money which will be required the 2025-2026 fiscal year for school purposes, specifying the several purposes and the amount for each. Such statement will be prepared and made available upon request to residents of District from May 6, 2025 through May 20, 2025, during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. (exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, or holidays) at the main offices in the Elementary School of the Middle/High School or at the District Office in the Elementary School.

AND NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that an election for members of the Board shall be held at four (4) positions on the Board consisting of the following: 2 three-year term (resulting from the expiration of the terms of Anne Winkley and Tracy Van Ameron), a two-year term (resulting from the vacant seat left by Salvatore De Luca Jr., which seat is currently held by Board appointee Jessica Sniatecki), and a one-year term (resulting from the resignation of Shannon Brett, which seat is currently held by Board appointee Stephanie Merkley). The candidates with the highest vote totals will each be elected to three (3) year terms commencing on July 1, 2025 and ending on June 30, 2028. The candidate with the third highest vote total will be elected to a (2) two-year term of office commencing on May 21, 2025 and ending June 30, 2027. The candidate with the fourth highest vote total will be elected to a (1) one-year term beginning on May 21, 2025 and ending on June 30, 2026.

AND NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that candidates for the office of member of the Board shall be nominated by petition, and that such petitions must be filed in the office of the Clerk of the District between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., not later than April 2025. Each petition shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of the District, shall be signed by at least 25 qualified voters of the District, or two percent of the number of voters who voted in previous Annual Meeting and Vote, whichever is greater, shall state the residence of the signer and shall state the name and residence of the candidate. Petitions may be obtained from the District Clerk in the Elementary School building during regular business hours Monday through Friday (except holidays).

AND NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that voting at the Annual Meeting and Vote shall consist of voting on the election of four members of the Board, voting on the following propositions, and voting on such other propositions as may be authorized by law and the rules of the Board:

PROPOSITION NO. 1
2025-2026 BUDGET

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the budget for the Holley Central School District (the "District") for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026, as presented by the Board of Education of the District, is hereby approved and adopted and the required funds therefor are hereby appropriated, and the necessary real property taxes required shall be raised by a tax on the taxable real property in the District to be levied and collected as required by law.

PROPOSITION NO. 2
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF
REPLACEMENT SCHOOL BUSES

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Holley Central School District (the "District"), is hereby authorized to purchase of replacement school buses and similar vehicle (and related equipment, machinery and apparatus) used in connection therewith, for use in the transportation program of the District, at an estimated maximum cost of \$250,200 and the sum of \$250,200, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the District and all other eligible legal fund sources; and in anticipation of such tax, bonds or other obligations (including, without limitation, obligations arising on leases, lease/purchase contracts or installment purchase contracts) of the District are hereby authorized to be issued in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$250,200 and shall be issued or entered into in accordance with applicable provisions of New York State law, and New York State Transportation Aid funds expected to be received by the District, anticipated to offset a substantial part of such costs, and such funds, to the extent received, shall be applied to offset and reduce the amount of taxes herein authorized to be levied.

PROPOSITION NO. 3
LOCAL LIBRARY APPROPRIATION

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the annual appropriation for the operation of the Community Fund Library is hereby increased by \$5,554 for a total of \$212,394, and the Board of Education of Holley Central School District is hereby authorized to levy and collect taxes in the District to the payment thereof.

AND NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that qualified voters may obtain applications for absentee and early mail ballots from the office of the Clerk of the District in the Elementary School building between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Completed applications for absentee and early mail ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than Tuesday, May 13, 2025, if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, and no later than Monday, May 19, 2025, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. No absentee or early mail ballot will be counted unless it has been received at the office of the Clerk of the District not later than 5:00 p.m. on May 20, 2025, the day of the Annual Meeting and Vote. A listing of all persons whom absentee and early mail ballots have been issued will be available for inspection by a qualified voter of the District at the District Clerk's office on each of the five days prior to Annual Meeting and Vote, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.

AND NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that a District resident unable to vote because of military service, as defined by Regulations of the Commissioner (Part 122), who is absent from the District on the day of the Annual Meeting and Vote, or the spouse, parent, or dependent of a voter as described above, accompanying or being with such voter, a qualified voter of the State of New York and a resident of the District, may request application for a military ballot. Applications may be obtained from Connie Nenni, District Clerk by mail at 3800 North Main Street, Holley, NY 14470, by telephone at (585) 638-6316, Ext. 21 or by email at cnenni@holleyscd.org. In a request for a military ballot application or ballot, military voter may indicate his/her preference for receiving the application or ballot by facsimile transmission or electronic mail. Ballot applications must be received by the District Clerk not later than 5:00 p.m. on April 24, 2025, and military ballots must be received at District Clerk's office not later than 5:00 p.m. on May 20, 2025, the day of the Annual Meeting and Vote.
