2022-2023 SGA Election Violations

Morgantown, W.Va. –

The elections committee received a total of six elections violations complaints against the Strive Ticket over the course of the campaign. Three of these violations were found to have merit by the Elections Committee and Judicial Court:

- Article 4, Section 3, #4: “No stickers or other campaign materials with adhesive backing shall be permitted to be placed on university property during the campaign”;
- Article 4, Section 3, #7: “Campaign materials shall not promote or be used in conjunction with any controlled substance (i.e. campaigning in or around establishments and/or alcoholic beverages)”;
- Article 7, Section 4, #12: “Students shall not engage in electioneering at an active polling location or while voting”.

The Judicial Court worked with the complainant and violators to reach an agreed resolution to these elections code violations, according to Judicial Court procedures. This agreed resolution outlined that the Strive Ticket would issue a public apology for violations of Elections Code sections 4.3.7 and 7.4.12. Their apology was posted on their official social media accounts and is attached to this press release.
