Dear Brother Gill:

The General Council of the Phi Delta Theta Fraternity voted to suspend the charter of the West Virginia University chapter at West Virginia University. This action was taken as a result of the chapter's risk management violations.

The charter suspension includes the loss of any rights to use the Fraternity name in association with any event or activity and to display the name or symbols of the Phi Delta Theta Fraternity. This suspension also restricts any continued operation, or any resemblance to operations. All members, unless otherwise notified, will be placed on alumni status as of today. Any violation of the above terms could result in individual loss of membership.

It is your responsibility, as the former president, to notify all the men of this action. *The Bond* and Ritual books should immediately be turned over to Province President Mark Pleiss who will send them to General Headquarters for safe keeping. The chapter's current checking account should be closed, with all funds being turned over to the chapter's advisory board. Any chapter social media accounts should be shut down and deleted.

Further, the insurance coverage for the undergraduate chapter and the chapter members is terminated effective immediately in accordance with the Fraternity's insurance program.

The General Council regrets the need to take this most serious form of action. However, it is felt the best way to ensure a bright future on the West Virginia University campus was to suspend the charter if we are to return the West Virginia Alpha chapter.
