Furthermore, following the budget hearing on December 1, 2025, City Council will hold a Public Hearing to consider enacting an ordinance to amend the business regulation and tax code of the City of Franklin to impose a tax on mechanical amusement devices within the City's jurisdiction and to establish penalties for noncompliance. A copy of the ordinance may be examined at City Hall during normal business hours.

During the regular City Council meeting on Dec. 1, Council members will consider the following ordinances for final reading: a bill making appropriations for municipal purposes; a bill establishing the 2026 Real Estate Tax; a bill establishing the 2026 Earned Income Tax; and a bill authorizing a new tax on mechanical amusement devices.
