



Rotten Egg Smell?

It could be a gas leak.

The odor of Mercaptan, a chemical that's added to natural gas to make it detectable, could be the first sign of a gas leak.

Remember these tips to stay safe.

- ▶ **LEAVE** the area immediately and evacuate others. Move at least the length of a football field away.
- ▶ **LEAVE** the door open behind you.
- ▶ **CALL** UGI's 24/7 emergency line at 1.800.276.2722 or 911 from a safe distance.
- ▶ **CALL** 911 immediately from a safe distance if you hear or see natural gas blowing.
- ▶ **DO NOT** use electronics such as phones, computers, appliances, or lamps.
- ▶ **DO NOT** use fire such as a lighter, match, or pilot light.
- ▶ **DO NOT** use vehicles or powered equipment.
- ▶ **DO NOT** use email or social media to contact UGI—CALL instead.
- ▶ **DO NOT** reenter the building until a UGI technician has inspected it.
