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Franklin's Applefest Tradition Returns for 43rd Year

'Best Three Days' Include Arts and Crafts, Food, Tours, Music and More.

FRANKLIN, PA – The Franklin Area Chamber of Commerce's popular Applefest event will be held October 2, 3, and 4 in the city's beautiful downtown parks and business district.

The 43rd Applefest will bring its traditional mix of arts, crafts, food, historical tours, car show, and entertainment once again.

"Applefest 43 bring with it another year of tradition for Franklin. We have over 300 vendors to fill the park. Lots of great food, including the apple pancake breakfast and the apple dumpling stand. One the region's most popular classic and antique car shows," said Applefest coordinator Jodi Lewis.

And of course, three days of entertainment in the bandstand and on Liberty Street. Along with many of the annual favorites, the Applefest 43 will feature two special musical acts.

Conway Turley will perform from 3:30 to 5:30 p.m. on Saturday at the bandstand. A singer/songwriter out of Nashville, Tennessee, Turley is traditional country artist and multi-instrumentalist.

Sunday's closing performance will be Honky Tonk Heroes from 3 to 5 p.m. at the bandstand. An award-winning outlaw country western band also performs a mix of classic, southern rock and blues throughout the tri-state area.

"We can't wait to see the parks and the streets packed with guests enjoying our beautiful downtown," Lewis said.

She works alongside the Applefest CORE committee to put together the event, which draws as many as 100,000 visitors to fill Franklin's parks, shops, restaurants, and hotels during the BEST THREE DAYS of the year.

"This festival is a huge undertaking for our CORE committee and wouldn't be possible without the support of our sponsors, the cooperation of the City of Franklin, our business owners, and the amazing volunteers," she said.

"Applefest couldn't happen without the dozens of people who freely give of their time to make our premier festival work so successful year after year," said Mike Dulaney, CORE Committee chairperson.

Like many past Applefests, every day of this



year's festival will feature arts, crafts and food vendors in West Park and South Park, (often referred to locally as Fountain Park and Bandstand Park) which sandwich the historic Venango County Courthouse. The farmers' market will be set up on 12th Street on Saturday.

A variety of musical acts will perform at the Bandstand Park stage throughout the three days and a few other entertainment acts will perform on Liberty Street. A complete list of the all the festival happenings and entertainment is available on the Applefest website (www.franklinapplefest.com) and Facebook page (@ApplefestFranklinPA).

Visitors are encouraged to stroll through the downtown to check out Franklin's thriving business district along Liberty, 12th, 13th and Elk streets. Many of the shops and restaurants hold special hours for the festival.

Several Franklin-based organizations offer historic tours including DeBence Antique Music World, Franklin Preservation, Franklin Rotary, Venango County Historical Society and St. John's Episcopal Church's Tiffany's Windows.

Also on the agenda this year is the Venango County Historical Society's Becoming America 250 Exhibit at 200 12th Street in Franklin. This limited-time exhibit offers a unique look at American history through rare artifacts, beautiful historical paintings and an immersive experience spanning the 17th through 19th centuries.

"Franklin is full of historically important places and things. Applefest provides a golden opportunity for visitors to see it all," Lewis said.

The festival also includes an apple pancake breakfast on Friday morning at St. Patrick Church; performances of "Mean Girls" at the Barrow-Civic Theatre on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights; the YMCA's Race for Any Pace 5K through town on Saturday morning; and a huge antique and classic car show on Liberty and 12th streets on Sunday.

To help better serve the vendors and attendees, the CORE Committee created the parking map to show the variety of lots available, including those being operated by area non-profit groups, clubs and organizations. The map can be found online at the Applefest website (www.franklinapplefest.com) and Facebook page (@ApplefestFranklinPA).

Public parking with shuttle service sponsored by KJ Consulting and Oil Region Alliance will be available on Saturday and Sunday from the Rocky Grove Volunteer Fire Department, Komatsu's 120 Liberty Street location, and French Creek Productions, which is a handicapped-only shuttle.

The Venango Regional Airport will hold a Fly-In on Saturday and Sunday, which includes complimentary breakfast and a shuttle service.

"At the chamber, we consider Applefest the crown jewel of Franklin's events, but it is certainly not the only gemstone in the community," Lewis said. "The city, businesses, social organizations and community groups in Franklin come together year after year to maintain a lively schedule and a welcoming atmosphere that continues to draw visitors from throughout the region and beyond."

The city boasts popular festivals year with Franklin on Ice, May Mart, Blues and Barbecue, 4th of July, Rock in River, Witch Walk and Light Up Night. There is live music nearly every Thursday, Friday and Saturday night from spring to fall. A variety of shops, restaurants and parking are all within an easy walk of each other, and the community theatre has an active calendar of concerts and productions.

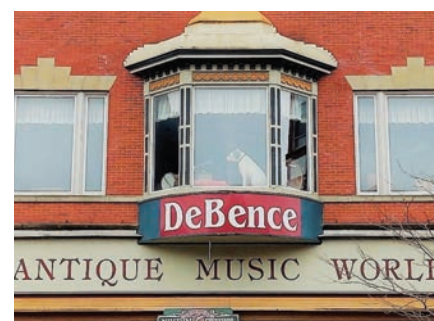

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Applefest® Named Among Nation's Top Craft Shows

FRANKLIN, PA – The Franklin Area Chamber of Commerce is proud to announce that vendors have once again named Applefest®, already recognized as the region's premier arts and craft event, among the most profitable in the country as listed in the industry/trade magazine Sunshine Artist.

"For the second year in a row, Applefest was named a top 30 festival nationwide. It is a honor and a reflection of the festival CORE committee, the chamber team, our numerous volunteers and member businesses, and the entire Franklin area

community," Applefest coordinator Jodi Lewis, said.

This year Applefest was ranked 30th Sunshine Artist's 200 Best. The rankings are split into two categories – Fine Art & Design for events that focus on unique, fine-art pieces and Classic & Contemporary Craft for events that focus on traditional or modern craft and production work. Applefest's ranking was in the Classic & Contemporary Craft Show category.

It is the third time in four years that the festival has made the list. Applefest was

selected for the 29th spot in 2025, and 64th in 2023.

"For more than four decades the chamber and our CORE committee have put in countless hours to ensure each festival is a quality event. From the annual apple pancake breakfast and pie tent to the popular car show to musical entertainment, every detail is considered and addressed to give vendors attendees an experience that will bring them back year after year," Lewis said. It is that collaborative effort of the chamber, the committee and the city's businesses and organizations that keep us in the spotlight and on this prestigious national list.

To determine the 200 Best, artists cast ballots from February through April to nominate their highest money-making shows from 2025.

As part of the nomination process, Sunshine Artist asks respondents to list the 10 most profitable art and/or craft shows where they exhibited during the previous year, indicate their level of gross sales at each event, and note whether they considered themselves fine artists or craftspeople for each event.

The results were tabulated using a weighted scale based on six sales levels to ensure all events competed

against each other fairly, according to the magazine. Sunshine Artist's 200 Best focuses solely on artists' show revenue, because that is the most objective indicator of a show's future success. Subjective attributes, such as artist treatment, amenities, attendance levels, management, and overall quality, can impact sales but are harder to gauge and therefore have no direct bearing on the rankings.

"As October approaches, we get into the final stretch of preparations for this year's Applefest, or as we like to call it The Best Three Days of the year," Lewis said. "Join us October 2, 3 and 4 in downtown Franklin and see why we were voted one of the best festivals in the entire country."

Applefest® is an annual festival organized by the Franklin Area Chamber of Commerce through the work of the CORE committee, the best volunteers, and with the financial support of numerous area businesses. The festival includes more than 300 craft and food vendors, three days of live entertainment, the area's largest car show, and other special tours and events. 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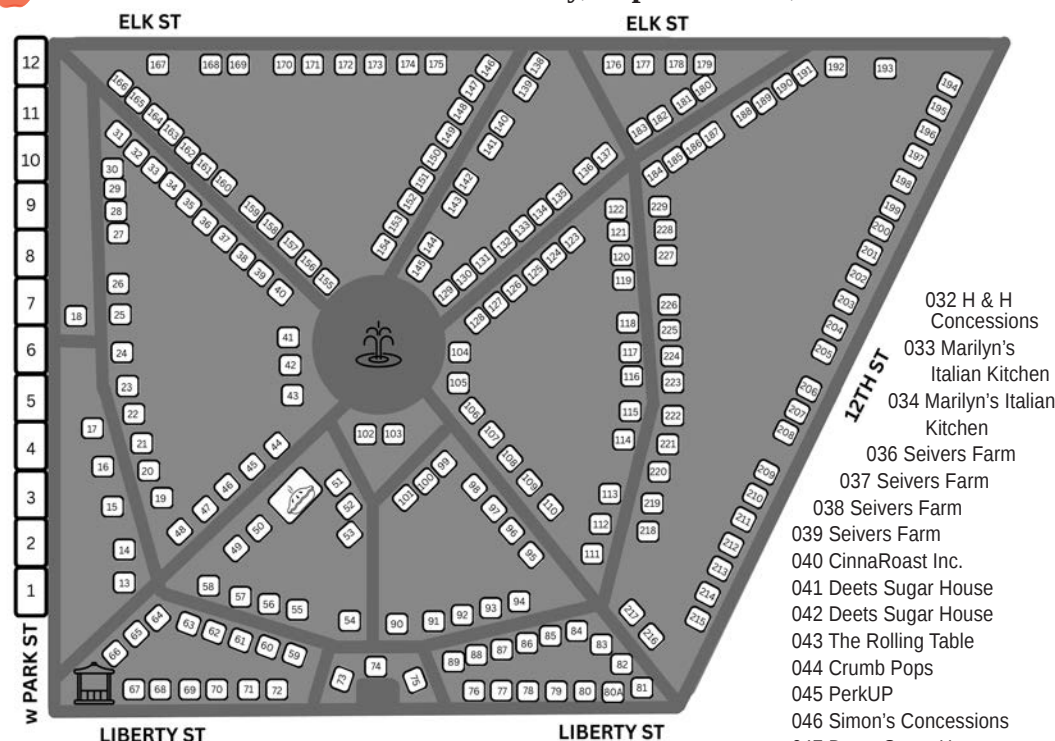
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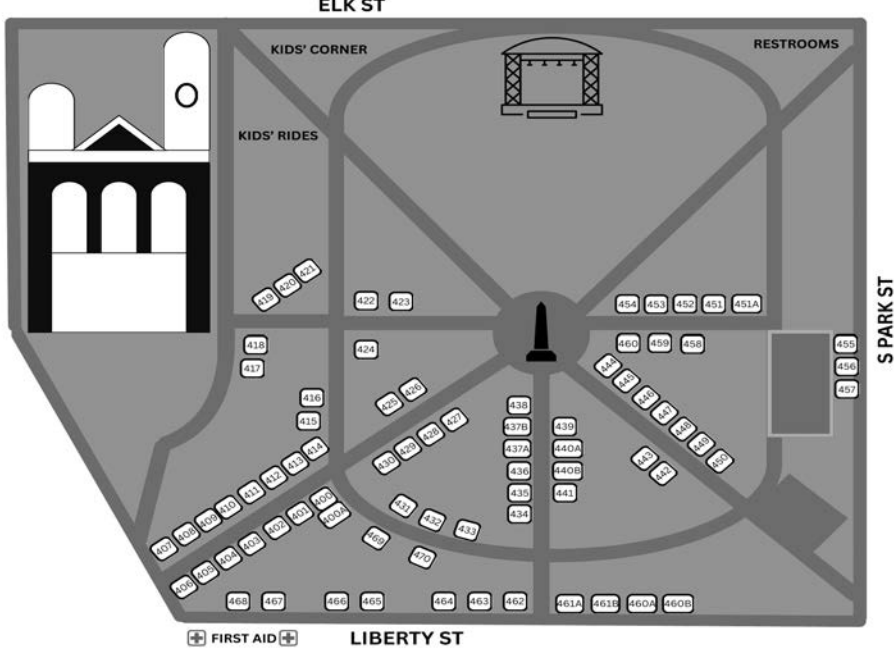
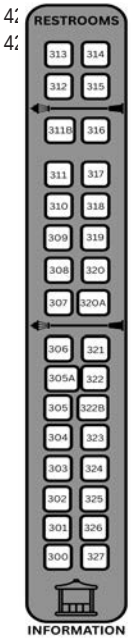
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
