

Franklin's Applefest Tradition Returns for 42nd Year

'Best Three Days' Include Arts and Crafts, Food, Tours, Music and More

FRANKLIN, PA – Say "pumpkin spice" to America, and they instantly know that fall is just around the corner. Say "Applefest" to folks in western Pennsylvania, and they know that the "Best Three Days" of October are just around the corner. This year's festival is October 3, 4, and 5th.

What started in 1982 as an apple pie baking contest has turned into one of the most recognizable arts and crafts festival in the tri-state area. The Franklin Area Chamber of Commerce and their Applefest CORE Committee are busy putting the finishing touches on this year's 42nd annual event.

With over 300 vendors on location, 40 plus volunteers on the ground, and approximately 30,000 people per day visiting, the rural City of Franklin, Pennsylvania, with a population of 6,000, turns into a bustling hub of activity from sun-up until sun-down in what could be the perfect story line for a Hallmark movie. If you have been here, you know exactly what we are saying. If you have not, you need to add it to your "must do" list.

In the quiet morning hours of the Wednesday before the 'fest, the CORE Committee and staff gather for final assignments and cheers for the beginning of our favorite time of year, and then



they head to the parks and streets. Before Noon many of our food vendors are surrounding the parks waiting for spaces to be marked so they can begin unloading. During that time, our sign crew travels throughout the county placing the necessary directional signs and, more than likely, having more fun than you can imagine. With morning assignments being completed, everyone gathers for lunch at the Chamber office to regroup for afternoon assignments. We conclude the day with the Applefest Kick-Off mixer where Chamber members celebrate the beginning of this annual extravaganza and share our appreciation for a community who joins us to make this happen.

By sunrise Friday morning, our community

is filled with the melodious tune of the crowds' chatter with hundreds lining up for coffee, hurrying to our pancake breakfast, and breathing in the scents of their favorite foods. For the "Best Three Days," visitors and locals alike fill our streets and businesses.

From the Apple Pancake breakfast on Friday to one of the largest classic car shows on Sunday, Applefest has something for everyone. Artisans and crafters offer a wide-variety of goods. And, did I mention that the air is filled with the smell of all of your favorite foods? Music and entertainment begins at 10:30 Friday morning, and the last tunes will be played at 4:45 on Sunday.

who have contributed significantly in the fields of academics, arts, sciences, humanity, community, athletics, vocations, technology, and business.



induction ceremony will be held on Oct. 2nd at Forever Farm.






