Lenten clothing and food drive

Please prayerfully consider getting involved in the 21st Annual Long-Sleeve Relief Drive this Lenten Season. Prayer and participation are needed to provide clothing, diapers, and personal hygiene products and food to fill the pantries that serve our working poor. The drive will run through Holy Thursday (April 2nd). Requests from agencies working for those living below the poverty line expanded this year and your help is needed. All individuals and parish groups are encouraged to participate in the drive.

For the Long-Sleeve Relief portion of the drive, light-colored, button-down long-sleeve shirts (men and women S, M & L sizes) are needed, and 100 percent cotton is preferred but not necessary. In addition to clean and gently used long-sleeve, button down shirts, the Farmworker Association of Florida is requesting the following items:

- Diapers for adults (all sizes)
- Laundry products
- Personal hygiene items (toilet paper, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, body wipes, brush, comb, soap)
- Cooling bandanas
- Socks
- Baby formula (Similac, Enfamil, etc.)
- Baby wipes

For cold weather:

- Gloves
- Winter caps
- Jackets
- Sweaters
- Backpacks
- Blankets
