Mr. LeDoux,

On May 15, 2013, your office received paperwork regarding a complaint submitted for violations of Colorado Revised Statutes by Board members of the Hartsel Fire Protection District.

My letter stated that the statute of limitation will expire on the first of these charges on July 12, 2013.

My letter also requested that if I was required to provide additional documentation (ie. a petition from members of the district requesting action by the DA's office) or if I needed to submit this paperwork to another agency (ie. Park County Sheriff's Office), that you would provide me with a list of your requirements.

I am hopeful that because I have not heard from you or your office that you are proceeding on the complaint and intend to file charges before the statute of limitation expires.

Last week, at the Hartsel Fire Protection Board of Directors meeting, two Board members recused from voting on payments to themselves stating a potential conflict of interest. A search of the Secretary of State website did not show that a conflict of interest was filed by anyone associated with the Hartsel Fire Protection District 72 hours prior to the meeting.

This appears to be another violation, and if that is case, a complaint will be filed with your office.

I would appreciate a response to this email informing me as to how you intend to proceed with my complaint.
