

Glade Hill Volunteer Fire Department Station Details

DESIGN/CONSULTATION PROCESS

- County began discussing a new joint Volunteer Fire and Career EMS facility at Glade Hill in 2011
- A new station was proposed in Glade Hill to meet growing Fire/EMS needs in 2016
- County purchased Turtle Hill property in 2016
- The county hired Thompson & Litton in 2020 to develop construction drawings and specifications.
- Project Construction cost \$4,800,000.

- Project Completion Estimated Spring 2023
 - Project Architect : Thompson & Litton
 - Project Contractor: Blair Construction

BUILDING SPECIFICATIONS

- Building designed for Glade Hill VFD primary use and Franklin County Public Safety Glade Hill Station Career EMS use
- The proposed facility is approx. 13,800 square feet with three (3) 80-foot-deep drive-thru apparatus bays capable of holding a minimum of six (6) apparatus. The facility will be capable of serving as an emergency shelter if needed.
