On or about August 5, 2024 the Genesee County Health Department will submit a request to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the release of the Healthy Homes Production Grant Program (HHP). The Healthy Homes Production Program is authorized under Section 501 and Section 502 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1970 (12 U.S.C. §§ 1701z-1 and 1701z-2), and funding is provided by the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023 (Public Law 117-328, approved December 29, 2022). This program is administered under HUD's Office of Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes (OLHCHH) for the following multi-year program/project: GLOW Healthy Homes Production. Will identify and provide assistance to 55 units of homes to eliminate health and safety hazards within Genesee, Livingston, Orleans and Wyoming Counties, for the purpose of the health and safety hazard remediation of 55 (estimated) housing units within the target areas that include all of Genesee, Livingston, Orleans, and Wyoming Counties in western NY. The County of Genesee, lead applicant/responsible entity, proposes 1 to 4-unit residential buildings may be enrolled in the program. All units will be privately owned. Only projects which do not require acquisition will be considered. All selected units shall be identified as having health and safety hazards. All units assisted will be occupied by households at or below 80% of the area median household income. Focus will be placed on assisting families with small children, aging adults, and persons with disabilities. Approximate cost per unit is \$12,000 for Healthy Homes Production funding. Anticipated work may include, but is not limited to, the following radon mitigation, lead remediation removal and/or replacement of hazardous building components, smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, cleaning, trip and fall hazards remediation, mold removal, electrical/plumbing repairs, etc. Genesee County is requesting the release of \$1,182,681.00 and will provide a match of \$179,831.95.

The proposed hazard control activities to be funded under this/these program(s) is/are categorically excluded from the National Environmental Policy Act requirements, but subject to compliance with some of the environmental laws and authorities listed at § 58.5 of 24 CFR Part 58. In accordance with §58.15, a tiered review process has been structured, whereby some environmental laws and authorities have been reviewed and studied for the intended target area(s) listed above. Other applicable environmental laws and authorities will be complied with when individual projects are ripe for review. Specifically, the target area(s) has/have been studied and compliance with the following laws and authorities has been achieved in this Tier 1 review: Airport Hazards, Air Quality, Coastal Barriers Resources, Coastal Zone Management, Endangered Species, Explosive and Flammable Hazards, Farmlands Protection, Floodplain Management, Noise Abatement and Control, Sole Source Aquifers, Wetlands Protection, Wild and Scenic Rivers, and Environmental Justice. Site-specific environmental reviews will include compliance with the following environmental laws and authorities for proposed projects funded under the program(s) listed above: Flood Insurance, Historic Preservation, Contamination and Toxic Substances. Should individual aggregate projects exceed the threshold for categorical exclusion detailed at §58.35(a), an Environmental Assessment will be completed and a separate Finding of No Significant Impact and Request for Release of Funds published. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the Genesee County Health Department. All comments received by August 2, 2024 will be considered by the Genesee County Health Department prior to authorizing submission of a Request for Release of Funds and Environmental Certification to HUD.

RELEASE OF FUNDS

The Genesee County Health Department certifies to HUD that Rochelle M. Stein in her official capacity as Chairperson of the Genesee County Legislature, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the Genesee County Health Department to utilize federal funds and implement the Program.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will consider objections to its release of funds and the Genesee County Health Department certification for a period of fifteen days following either the anticipated submission date (cited above) or HUD's actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if the objections are on one of the following bases: (a) that the Certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Genesee County Health Department (b) the Genesee County Health Department has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the Genesee County Health Department has committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. WHEREAS, the capital project herein/after described has been determined to be a Type II Action pursuant to the regulations of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation promulgated pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act, which it has been determined, as such, will not have any significant adverse impact on the environment; and WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mount Morris, Livingston County, New York, on March 15, 2021, duly adopted a bond resolution authorizing the issuance of \$1,000,000 bonds of said Village to pay the cost of the construction of improvements to and reconstruction of the Village Water Treatment Plant, including original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, site improvements and incidental improvements and 4137-9501-0897.1 expenses in connection therewith, in and for the Village of Mount Morris, Livingston County, New York, and WHEREAS, it has now been determined that the maximum estimated cost of such specific object or purpose is \$1,155,000, an increase of \$155,000 over that previously authorized; and WHEREAS, it is now desired to authorize the issuance of an additional \$155,000 bonds of said Village for such specific object or purpose to pay a portion of the cost thereof; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the total voting strength of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mount Morris, Livingston County, New York, as follows: Section 1. For the specific object or purpose of paying additional costs of the construction of improvements to and reconstruction of the Village Water Treatment Plant, including original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, site improvements and incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, in and for the Village of Mount Morris, Livingston County, New York, there are hereby authorized to be issued an additional \$155,000 bonds of the Village of Mount Morris, Livingston County, New York, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law. Section 2. It is hereby determined that the maximum estimated cost of such specific object or purpose is now determined to be \$1,155,000 which specific object or purpose is hereby authorized at said maximum estimated cost. The plan for the financing of the \$1,155,000 maximum estimated cost thereof is as follows: 4137-9501-0897.1 -2- (a) By the issuance of the \$1,000,000 bonds of said Village authorized to be issued pursuant to bond resolution dated March 15, 2021; and (b) Section 3. By issuance of the \$155,000 bonds of said Village herein authorized. It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is forty (40) years, pursuant to subdivision 1 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, calculated from the date of issuance of the first obligation issued therefor. It is hereby further determined that the maximum maturity of the serial bonds herein authorized will exceed five years. Section 4. The faith and credit of said Village of Mount Morris, Livingston County, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged to the payment of the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations becoming due and payable in such year. There shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property in said Village a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same become due and payable. Section 5. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the serial bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the Village Treasurer, the chief financial officer of such village. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said Village Treasurer, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law. Section 6. The powers and duties of advertising such bonds for sale, conducting the sale and awarding the bonds, are hereby delegated to the Village Treasurer, who shall advertise 4137-9501-0897.1 -3- such bonds for sale, conduct the sale, and award the bonds in such manner as she shall deem best for the interests of said Village, including, but not limited to, the power to sell said bonds to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation; provided, however, that in the exercise of these delegated powers, the Village Treasurer shall comply fully with the provisions of the Local Finance Law and any order or rule of the State Comptroller applicable to the sale of municipal bonds. The receipt of the Treasurer shall be a full acquittance to the purchaser of such bonds, who shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchase money. Section 7. All other matters except as provided herein relating to the bonds herein authorized including the date, denominations, maturities and interest payment dates, within the limitations prescribed herein and the manner of execution of the same, including the consolidation with other issues, and also the ability to issue bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, shall be determined by the Village Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer of such Village. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law, and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals, in addition to those required by Section 51.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the Treasurer shall determine consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law. Section 8. The Village Treasurer is hereby further authorized, at her sole discretion, to execute a project finance and/or loan agreement, and any other agreements with the New York State Department of Health and/or the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation, including amendments thereto, and including any instruments (or amendments thereto) in the effectuation thereof, in order to effect the financing or refinancing of the specific object or purpose described in Section 1 hereof, or a portion thereof, by a bond, and/or note issue of said 4137-9501-0897.1 -4- Village in the event of the sale of same to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation. Section 9. The power to issue and sell notes to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation pursuant to Section 169.00 of the Local Finance Law is hereby delegated to the Village Treasurer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents as may be prescribed by said Treasurer consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law. Section 10. only if: 1) The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said Village is not authorized to expend money, or 2) The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or 3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution. Section 11. This resolution shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150 - 2. Other than as specified in this resolution, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein. Section 12. Upon this resolution taking effect, the same shall be published in full or summary form in the official newspaper of said Village for such purpose, together with a notice of the Village Clerk in substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law. Section 13. 4137-9501-0897.1 This resolution is adopted subject to permissive referendum.

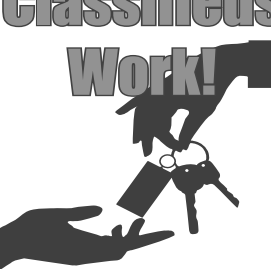
