


Horseshoe Solar Energy Construction Notice November 2025



Beginning on or about November 17, 2025, Horseshoe Solar Energy LLC (HSS) will install seven 8-inch high-density polyethylene (HDPE) conduits beneath the Genesee River using horizontal directional drilling. The conduits will be used to house electric collection lines for the Horseshoe Solar Energy Project, a 180-megawatt (MW) solar-powered electric generation facility located in the Town of Caledonia, Livingston County and the Town of Rush, Monroe County, New York. Construction activities will include placement of timber matting to provide temporary access to the bore pit locations, staking and flagging of work areas and sensitive resources, stripping and stockpiling of topsoil in agricultural areas, installing erosion and sediment controls, constructing bore pits, drilling pilot holes, installing the HDPE conduits, backfilling the pits, and restoring the area. In a later phase of construction, electric collection lines will be pulled through the conduits.

This notice is being provided in accordance with Section 5.2 of the Siting Permit issued by the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission (ORES) on December 9, 2022, authorizing the Facility. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

When completed, the Project will consist of an approximately 180-MW major solar electric generating facility. The Facility will include the installation of photovoltaic panel arrays, as well as associated electrical collection lines, inverters, a collection substation, a point of interconnection switchyard, fencing, access roads and an operations and maintenance building. All Facility components will be located within an area encompassing approximately 1,450 acres.

THE CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

The construction activities that are the subject of this notice are scheduled to begin on or about November 17, 2025, and are expected to be completed by March 31, 2026. Construction activity will be limited to the hours between 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Sunday and national holidays. The construction location and transportation routes are shown on the attached map.


