### **ENTERING ABSENCES IN FRONTLINE - CERTIFIED STAFF**

- Certified Staff absences requiring a substitute must be entered into Frontline as a Half-Day or Full-Day request.
- Substitutes are only paid as a Half-Day or Full-Day assignment, they cannot be assigned to Custom-Days, including Quarter-Day absences.
- If you are taking a Quarter-Day absence (2-hours), you are responsible to find coverage for that time. Enter your absence in Frontline and select No Sub Required..
- If you have questions, please check with Ryan Sparks or Brigitte Sindeldecker BEFORE entering your absence in Frontline.

#### **CLASSROOM USE OF STREAMING SERVICES**

Showing consumer media like movies, documentaries, and TV shows in the classroom has always had district rules and guidance. However, as most media have moved over to streaming services the popularity of these services may have caused previous rules and guidance to be disregarded or forgotten.

Modern streaming services (Netflix, Disney+, Prime Video, etc.) are licensed to individuals for their personal use. Using a streaming service in a classroom or other setting outside your home is almost always a violation of that service's Terms of Service. These sites remain open as staff can access content personally during non-work time available to them, however this access does not indicate that these services are approved for use with students.

Going forward technical support for these and other streaming services will be given lower priority over approved resources and other classroom technology needs. This allows us to ensure we remain good stewards of district resources. Staff should ensure they are familiar with district guidance around the use of copyrighted materials and other media in the classroom.
