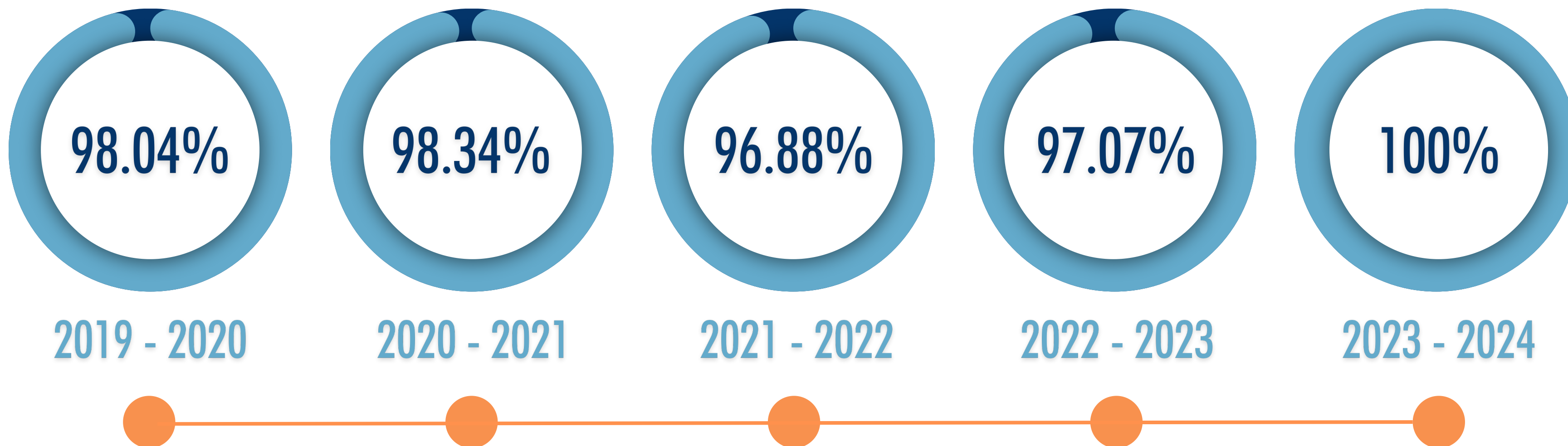

- Meet NCDPI licensure requirements
- Vetted through an extensive application process including supervisor and colleague reference checks and a criminal background check
- J-1 visa holders eligible to teach in the U.S. for up to 5 years
