

REVISED NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED RATES AND CHARGES

Property owners, ratepayers, and other interested parties in or served or to be served by the sewage works of the Town of Bremen, Indiana ("Town"), are hereby notified that an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 6-2023 establishing sewage works rates and charges for the services to be rendered by the utility was introduced at a meeting of the Town Council held on October 27, 2025 ("Ordinance"). At the meeting of the Town Council to be held at 4:30 p.m. (Bremen time) on November 10, 2025, in the Bremen Town Hall, 111 South Center Street, Bremen, Indiana, there will be a public hearing on the matter of the rates and charges, and consideration of adoption of the Ordinance, which provides in part as follows:

Phase I rates shall be effective January 1, 2026

Phase II rates shall be effective January 1, 2027

At such hearing and prior to final adoption of the Ordinance, all interested parties may appear and be heard. A copy of the Ordinance may be examined at the Bremen Town Hall.

Users of the sewage works located outside the corporate boundaries of the Town may be entitled to petition the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission under Ind. Code §8-1.5-3-8.3 to review and adjust the rates and charges imposed on the users if a petition under Ind. Code §8-1.5-3-8.2 is not filed.

Please note that there is no surcharge applicable to users outside the corporate boundaries of the Town. Therefore, the rates and charges are not subject to review by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission under Ind. Code § 8-1.5-3-8.3.
