record attendance of 250 people gathered to celebrate the past year of Ocean Community Chamber of Commerce accomplishments. The event took place at Paddy's Beach Club on June 16. Thanks to everyone who attended, those who donated auction items, and those who volunteered to assist with the production. Much of the program may be viewed on The Chamber's Facebook page where it was filmed live. Also, the tribute videos to Key Award winners Beth and Jeff Frenette and Bruce Morrow are also available on Facebook. The 12 minute film dedicated to Citizen of the Year Spike Lobdell is available on The Chamber's Youtube Channel as well as on Facebook. It was produced by Chris Walsh.

Some of the highlights of the event included a stretch limo ride for Mr. Lobdell, courtesy of Joshua's Worldwide Transporation and a free lottery ticket for everyone. Guests were moved by a poignant acceptance speech by Mr. Lobdell, centered around his love of sailing, instilled at a young age by his parents, and desire to make the sport accessible to more children. A custom handmade sail that said "What's Next?", a reference to the last words Spike asks at the end of each staff meeting at New England Science and Sailing was a fun prop. Gifts included chamber gift certificates, a custom painted platter designed by Susan Pfiefer Scala and a \$1,000 donation to NESS to support their youth sailing programs.

Maria Allen, Chairman of the Board, was elected to a second term at the helm. She enthusiastically accepted this role and delivered the following address to the membership:

"I have always been very proud of my affiliation with this Chamber of Commerce but this past year, serving as Chairman of the Board, has been an incredible personal honor. The Ocean Community Chamber responded to an unimaginable set of challenges and performed at an exceptional level. We kept our promise to small businesses. We had their backs. We did not close our office. Instead we extended our efforts to 7 days a week. We led with vision and confidence and were continuously out ahead of the situation and removing hurdles to small business success. We set the bar for delivering solutions and we stood alone in our regional response efforts. We were the only business group that provided grants funds to struggling small businesses. We worked hard to help everyone regardless of whether or not they were chamber members. We were the only group that provided grant funds to employees of small businesses. We were the only group that generated thousands in retail sales through innovative Facebook Live marketing videos. We were the only group that persevered and saved time honored community events by reimagining them and creatively producing. Some are just this month hosting their first in person event while we have held 26 Covid safe productions. These activities brought joy to families, but more importantly, they bolstered our local economy when it was needed most. I will never forget, nor will our many Board members who participated, the long line of mask-wearing patrons waiting for their temperatures to be checked to enter our art festival. We will never forget the faces of kids and their parents as the Chamber's 3 Easter bunnies visited 297 homes in a well-orchestrated

weekend extravaganza that kept this tradition alive and kept families safe. Thank you to everyone who donated the 24,000 pieces of candy and to the many volunteers who stuffed eggs or helped the Bunny Brigade. We will never forget the smiling faces in cars that lined up a ½ mile long waiting to get into our Holiday Light Trail on Chamber Way that Frank Ritacco and others helped create, with over \$8,000 worth of inflatables that we purchased thanks to community support. We will not forget the sight of couples dancing in the streets to live music – the ONLY live music taking place anywhere---and the awesome attendance during 12 Sunday Fundays. All of these activities kept community spirits up and kept sales strong for our members.

We could not have done these things without the volunteers, the steadfast support of the Westerly Police, and all of you who continued to renew your membership and sponsor events. We also could not have done it without an extraordinary chamber staff that consisted of just 2 powerhouse women willing to go

way above and beyond with their efforts.

Despite the challenges, The Chamber had a blockbuster year in terms of delivering member value. Our gift certificate program reached a remarkable record high- \$227,000, 7 times more than ANY other chamber in RI or CT. Every penny of those funds went to support our member retail and service businesses.

And on top of everything else we accomplished as a Chamber, we produced the Pop Up Book of Stonington through our Foundation. It celebrates Stonington, our sister community, and over \$64,000 in books and donations has been awarded our Foundation in just 5 months. Every penny has been donated to schools and charities.

While our efforts are undeniable and our results are impressive, we have more excitement in the works for the coming year. My continued confidence and optimism comes from working alongside my fellow Board of Directors who are hard working, humble and very dedicated. They have done a great job of assuring our chamber is fiscally strong once again. I also want to thank the Westerly town council and the Stonington Board of Selectmen for their support of The Chamber.


