To Members of our Iowa Falls CSD Community:

Even though we are in the middle of a mass shutdown, our district still needs to move forward with some decisions involving our facilities. The Iowa Falls Community School District is looking for parents, community members and staff members to serve on a District Facility Committee. The initial goal of this group will be to provide feedback to the Board of Education based on the recent Facility Assessment completed by KCL Engineering and DeNovo Construction.

Due to the recent national and local health concerns, this group will need to meet virtually. We would like to have our first meeting in late April, with a follow-up meeting to be scheduled two weeks later. The first meeting will focus on a review of the Facility Assessment. The date and times of these meetings have yet to be scheduled, due to the unknown meeting recommendations that may be put out by the state.

At this time, we are simply asking for interested individuals to reply to a Google Form. We will most likely use the Zoom platform for this meeting, which allows individuals to join either by computer/tablet (preferred method) or by cell phone. The link for completing the Google Form is:
