The board members in attendance were Lance Granzow, Renee McClellan and BJ Hoffman. McClellan moved and Hoffman seconded the motion to approve the day's agenda. All Ayes. Motion carried. Roll Call Vote: "Ayes" McClellan and Granzow. "Nays" None. Motion carried. Resolution No. 2026-26 is hereby summarized as follows: Resolution No. 2026-26. A Resolution for Ballot Measure on Emergency Medical Services Property Tax Levy. The Hardin County Board of Supervisors approved placing a public measure on the November 3, 2026, general election ballot seeking voter authorization for an annual Emergency Medical Services property tax levy not to exceed \$1.00 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation. The levy would raise approximately \$1,200,000 annually for seven years, beginning with the first applicable fiscal year following the election. Revenues would be deposited into the County's EMS trust fund and distributed to the respective cities and townships for authorized EMS purposes. The resolution also directs publication of the ballot measure at least 60 days before the election. The measure requires approval by 60 percent of those voting on the question. The full text of this resolution is available at the Office of the Hardin County Auditor during regular business days and hours. Hoffman moved and McClellan seconded the motion to instruct County Attorney Meyer to work with Assistant Chief Brian Perry to draft an agreement for a four-year, interest-free \$50,000 loan from LOST funds to the appropriate entities associated with the Providence Township Fire Department/New Providence Fire Department Foundation, ensuring proper entity naming and alignment with anticipated asset transfers. All Ayes. Motion carried. Hoffman moved and McClellan seconded the motion to approve the Community Betterment match grant for Four Five Rentals LLC (Ackley) for a sign grant. All Ayes.
