II. REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION OF REVIEWABILITY DETERMINATION

Presbyterian Village d/b/a Grand Jivante, Hardin County: Replacement of a 70-bed nursing facility within the same county.

The Council will allow the project sponsor 15 minutes to make an oral presentation to the Council, followed by an oral presentation from a representative or representatives of the community for a total of 15 minutes (30 minutes total, 15 minutes from each side). The Council's role is limited to determining whether the Health Facilities Council's decision made on August 4, 2015 to not affirm the Department's non-reviewability determination should be reconsidered. Each presenter is encouraged to offer oral testimony that is relevant to the question of whether the Council's August 4th decision should be reconsidered, including whether the request for reconsideration offers new significant, relevant information which was unavailable at the date of the August 4th meeting; whether there have been significant changes in factors or circumstances relied upon by the Council in reaching its decision; whether the sponsor has demonstrated that the Council materially failed to follow its adopted procedures in reaching its decision; or such other bases as the Council determines constitutes good cause. If the Council determines the August 4th decision should be reconsidered, it will set the matter for reconsideration at its October meeting. If the Council determines the August 4th decision should not be reconsidered, the Council will proceed with review of Grand Jivante's CON application at its October meeting.
